Pursuant to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization.

Article I The name of the Limited Liability Company: Artisan Steel, LLC

Article II The duration of the Limited Liability Company is 30 years.

Article III The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purpose(s):

To engage in the construction or repair of pre-engineered metal buildings and metal roofing for private and public works of all kinds, with such work being improvements to such property, and the doing of any other business and contracting work incidental to or connected with such work, including demolition. The foregoing purposes and activities shall be interpreted as examples only and not as limitations, and nothing therein shall be deemed as prohibiting the LLC from engaging in any lawful act or activity for which an LLC may be organized under the laws of Alabama.
