KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand and 00/100 (\$126,000.00) Dollars, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned GRANTORS, **Barry L. Hatton and Michele P. Hatton**, husband and wife, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTORS do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, **John Chafton and Tammie Chafton**, husband and wife (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of revision, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:
