
FIRST I hereby revoke any and all other Wills, Testaments, and Codicils heretofore made by me.

SECOND I direct my executors, hereinafter named, to pay all of my funeral expenses and just debts as soon after my demise as practicable.




FOURTH If one son precedes the other in death, the entire estate will go to the surviving son.
