KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of Five Hundred Ten Thousand and 00/100 (\$510,000.00) DOLLARS, and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned GRANTORS, **Larry Davis and Mary Ann Davis, husband and wife** (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTORS do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEE, **Harry Jay Barker, Jr. and Amy Barker, Husband and Wife**, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of SHELBY, State of Alabama, to-wit:


Subject to existing easements, current taxes, restrictions and covenants, set-back lines and rights of way, if any, of record.


