


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of Eleven Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS (\$11,000.00) to the undersigned GRANTOR in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, the undersigned Carolyn Edith Yawn Mann, married, and Margie Lynn Driver Yawn, as Trustee for Thomas Ray Yawn, Hollie Elizabeth Yawn, and Jessica Lynn Yawn under the will of Robert Hollis Yawn, deceased (herein referred to as GRANTOR, whether one or more) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Johnny M. Howard, Jr. and Pamela A. Howard (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in SHELBY County, Alabama to-wit:

A parcel of land situated in the South half of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at an iron pin found locally accepted to be the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 17; thence run North along the West line of said quarter-quarter section for a distance of 705.59 feet to an iron pin set; thence continue along last stated course for a distance of 909.90 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the right of 74 degrees, 09 minutes, 58 seconds and run in a Northeasterly direction for a distance of 467.66 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the right of 22 degrees, 39 minutes, 34 seconds and run in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 427.65 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the right of 70 degrees, 32 minutes, 34 seconds and run in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 96.12 feet to an iron pin set on a curve to the left, having a central angle of 66 degrees, 08 minutes, 18 seconds and a radius of 100.00 feet; thence run in a Southeasterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 115.43 feet to an iron pin set on a compound curve to the left, having a central angle of 26 degrees, 01 minutes, 04 seconds and a radius of 455.00 feet; thence run in a Southeasterly to Northeasterly direction along the arc of said curve for a distance of 206.61 feet to an iron pin found; thence run tangent to last stated curve in a Northeasterly direction for a distance of 121.36 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the left of 76 degrees, 41 minutes, 43 seconds and run in a Northwesterly direction for a distance





of 8.31 feet to an iron pin found at the Southwest corner of the Howard property according to a survey done by Surveying Solutions, Inc. dated November 25, 2003; thence turn an angle to the right of 92 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds and run in an Easterly direction along the South line of said Howard property for a distance of 30.02 feet to an iron pin set at the point of beginning; thence continue along last stated course for a distance of 903.74 feet to a point on the centerline of a creek; thence turn an angle to the right of 128 degrees, 58 minutes, 28 seconds and run in a Southwesterly direction along the centerline of said creek for a distance of 77.06 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the right of 05 degrees, 17 minutes, 23 seconds and run in a Southwesterly direction along the centerline of said creek for a distance of 44.51 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the left of 15 degrees, 06 minutes, 49 seconds and run in a Southwesterly direction along the centerline of said creek for a distance of 38.03 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the right of 60 degrees, 50 minutes, 58 seconds and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 803.36 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the right of 90 degrees, 59 minutes, 42 seconds and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 39.11 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the left of 02 degrees, 59 minutes, 42 seconds and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 85.95 feet to the point of beginning; said parcel containing 2.44 acres, more or less.






EXHIBIT B

COVENANTS & RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Minimum building set back line shall be no less than 100 feet from any property line.
- 2. There shall be no further division of lands herein described, except that GRANTEE shall be allowed to divide this property one time, with a minimum division of no less than 10 acres. GRANTEE is aware that permission must be obtained from Shelby County Planning Department for division. Purchaser shall be allowed to sell a portion of this property to adjoining property owners Larry and Linda Bristow.
- 3. It shall be the responsibility of each owner to prevent the occurrence of any unclean, unsightly refuse or garbage on the described parcels.
- 4. No one story dwelling house of less than 2000 square feet of heated area, exclusive of porches, carports, basements and decks or terraces and no one and one-half or two story dwellings having less than 2600 square feet of heated area shall be erected on any parcel.
- 5. No detached outbuilding, storage building or garage shall be erected closer to the street than the front of the dwelling.
- 6. No trailers, temporary buildings, garages or other buildings shall be built and used for residence purposes prior to the completion of a dwelling on said lots. All residences shall be site-built homes. No mobile homes, modular homes or manufactured homes are allowed.
- 7. No unused or inoperable vehicles or water craft shall be stored on the property unless stored in a garage or outbuilding.
- 8. If any person shall violate or attempt to violate any of the covenants and restrictions contained herein, it shall be lawful for any person or persons owning any of the adjoining parcels to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity, against the person or persons violating any such covenants and restrictions, and either to prevent him or them from doing or to recover damages for such violation. It being understood that this right extends not only to the present owners of said property, but also to any future property owners therein.
- 9. Property shall be used for residential purposes only. No commercial uses are permitted.
