ORDER

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard on Plaintiff's Application, Affidavit, and Entry of Default, and the Defendants having been served on October 28, 2004, but failing to appear or otherwise defend this action, and upon the affidavit of the Plaintiff and for good cause being shown, it is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. That a money judgment is hereby entered in favor of the Plaintiff, Sherman Industries, Inc., and against the Defendant, RJ Bop General Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$2,364.54.
2. That a lien is hereby affixed and established for the amount of Plaintiff's judgment on all the right, title and interest of the Defendant, James Russell Coston, on the following described real property:

**Lot 16, according to the Survey of High Hampton Sector 4, as recorded in Map Book 26, Page 47, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.**

**Also known as 108 Hampton Cove, Pelham, Alabama 35124**

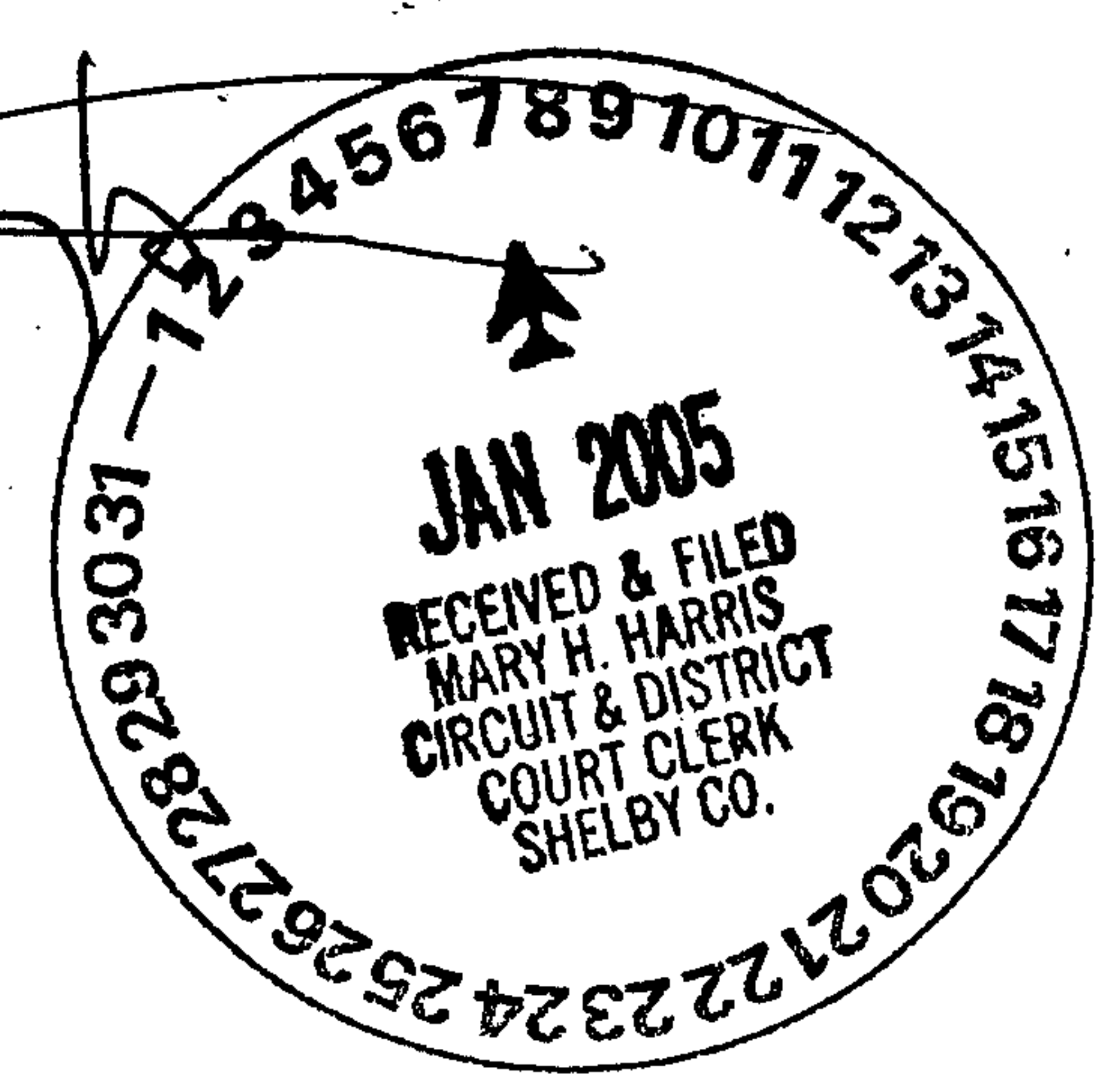
