undertaking to which it is attached, continue to be valid and binding on the Company.

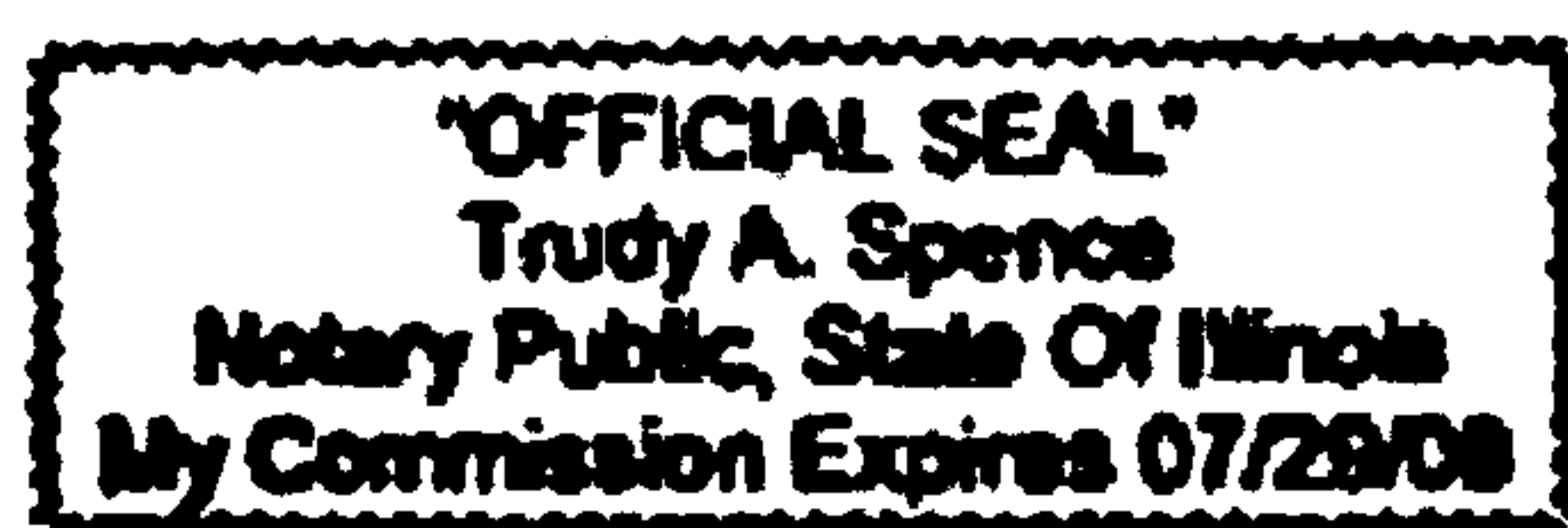
