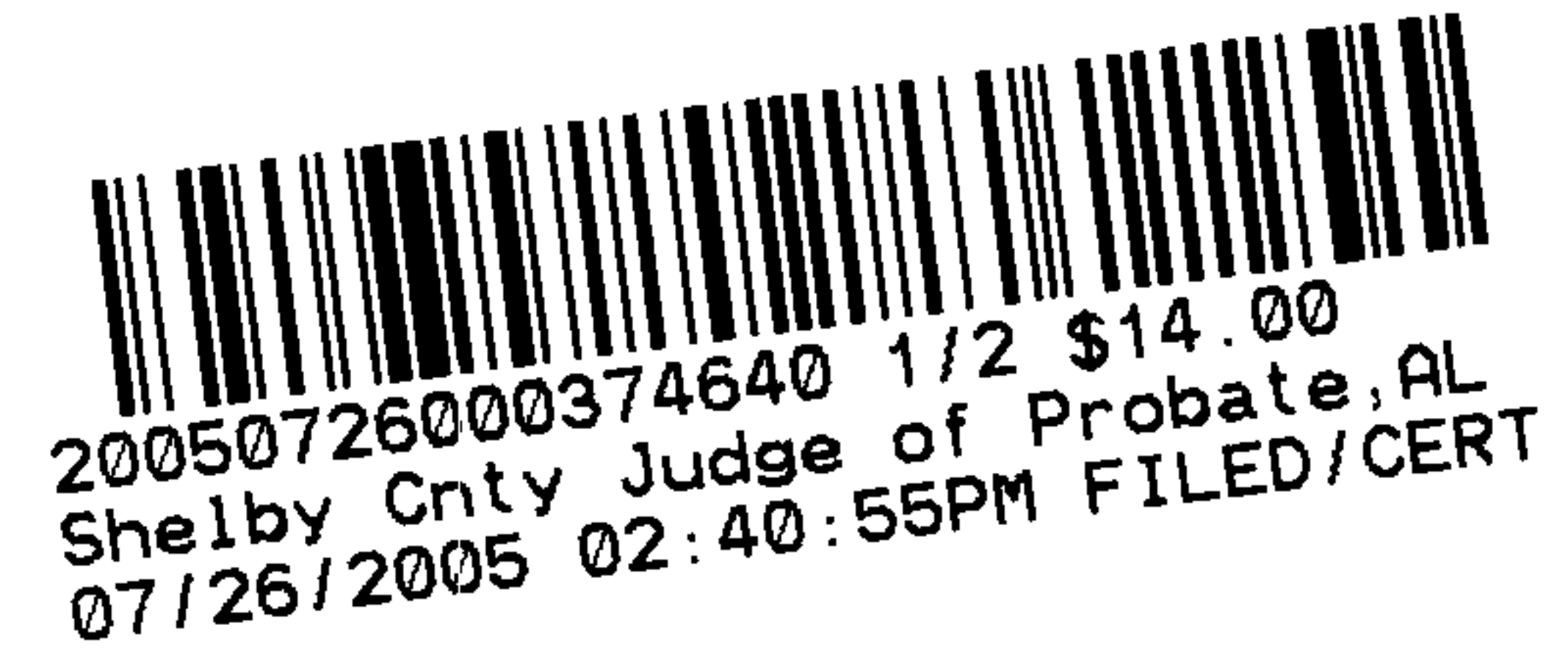

LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Jana B. Jelich, a legal resident of Mobile County, AL, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Margaret A. GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power and authority to execute said documents.

THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY shall not be affected by my disability, incompetency, or incapacity. It is intended that this power of attorney is to become effective immediately upon execution and shall continue in effect during any subsequent disability, incompetency or incapacity as so provided by §26-1-2, Code of Alabama (1975).

AND I HEREBY declare that the execution of said documents done hereunder by my said attorney shall be binding on me, and my heirs, legal and personal representatives and assigns.

THIS POWER OF ATTORNEY is specifically limited to the acts specified herein and shall terminate immediately upon the satisfactory closing of the sale of all lots in the Brett Subdivision in which I have an interest.
