**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF**

TRIPLE PLAY, L.L.C.

Pursuant to the Code of Alabama, § 10-21-0, et. Seq., the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Limited Liability Company shall be: TRIPLE PLAY, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The period of duration of the Company shall be from the date of filing of these Articles of Organization with the Office of the Judge of Probate for Shelby County County, Alabama until the first to occur of the following:

- (1) Fifty (50) years from the date of filing of these Articles of Organization, or,
- (2) Dissolution of the Company pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama or the Operating Agreement of the Company, as in effect from time to time.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the purpose of owning and renting property located at 629 Main Street, Montevallo, Alabama 35115.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTERED AGENT/OFFICE

The location and street address of the initial registered office shall be at 1380 Highland Street, Montevallo, Alabama 35115, and its registered agent at such address shall be Jimmy Maddox.

The member(s) may permit the admission of additional members upon the consent of two-thirds of the members of the company.

ARTICLE VIII


The disassociation of any member shall constitute a dissolution event, unless the business of the company is continued upon the written consent of all of the remaining members within ninety (90) days after such disassociation and provided there are at least two remaining members or at least one remaining member and a new member is admitted.

ARTICLE IX

All members will receive compensation from the L.L.C. on at least a yearly basis, the amount of such compensation to be determined by a majority of the members.




