WHEREAS, JOHN W. EVANS AND WIFE, ANNIE J. EVANS, and REUBEN EVANS, an unmarried man acquired title to the hereinafter described property with joint rights of survivorship, by virtue of that certain deed dated September 15, 1978 and recorded in Book 314, Page 991, Probate Records of Shelby County, Alabama; and,

WHEREAS, the said JOHN W. EVANS a/k/a JOHN WESLEY EVANS, SR. died on or about the 29th day of October, 1978; a true and correct copy of his death certificate being attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference; and,

WHEREAS, at the death of the said JOHN W. EVANS, he did leave surviving him the said ANNIE J. EVANS and REUBEN EVANS; and,

WHEREAS, the said JOHN W. EVANS AND WIFE, ANNIE J. EVANS, and REUBEN EVANS, an unmarried man have been in open, hostile and continuous possession of the hereinafter described property since September 15, 1978, paying all ad valorem taxes and assessments on such property during their time of ownership; and,

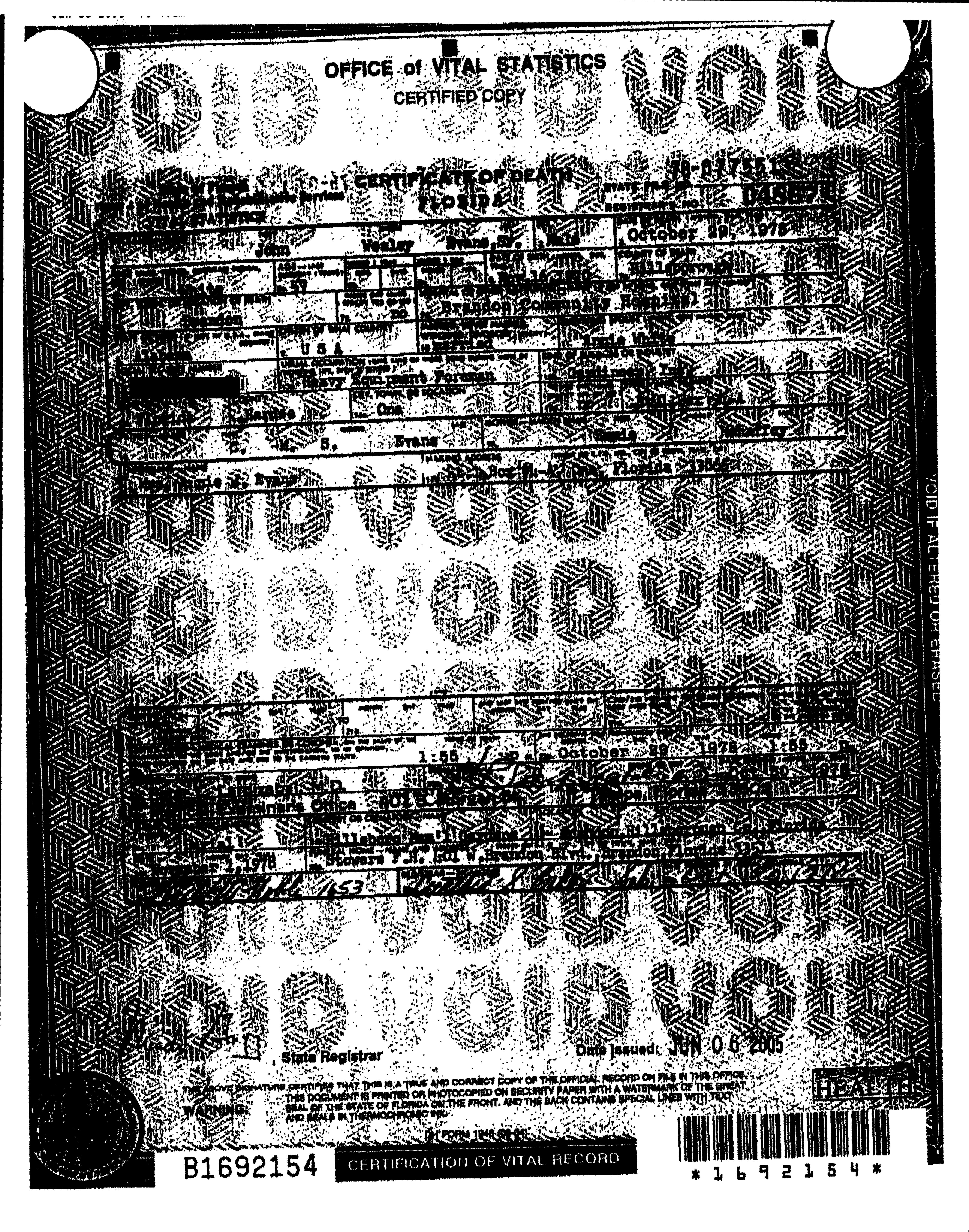
Begin at the northeast corner of Section 5, Township 24 North, Range 13 east, Shelby County, Alabama. Thence in a westerly direction along the north boundary of said section 312 feet to the point of beginning; thence turn 91 degrees and 35 minutes to the left in a southerly direction 985.27 feet to the intersection with the center line of an old road; thence turn 68 degrees and 57 minutes to the right in a southwesterly direction along said centerline 901.50 feet to the point of beginning of the arc of a curve, tangent to said straight line, turning to the left, having a central angle of 61 degrees and 34 minutes and radius of 170.97 feet and having a chord 175.00 feet in length; thence southwesterly along said arc, which is along said center line 183.71 feet to the intersection with the center line of right-of-way of southern railroad; thence turn 66 degrees and 46 minutes to the right from said chord in a northwesterly direction along said center line of a branch 1787.00 feet, more or less, to intersection with the center line of a branch 1787.00 feet, more or less to intersection with said north boundary of Section 5; thence in an easterly direction along said north boundary 409.00 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
