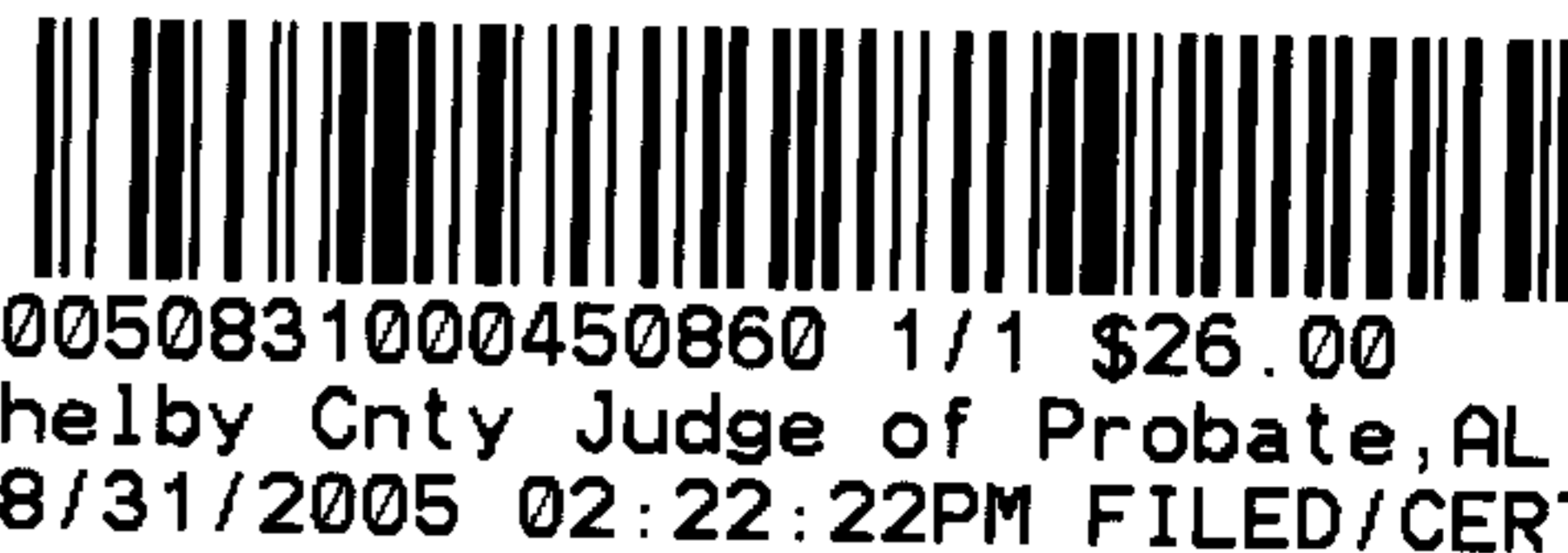

WARRANTY DEED, JOINT TENANTS WITH RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP
