ARTICLE XVI,— Section S.— Execution of contracts, surety bonds and undertakings.



Such attorneys-in-fact, subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the company by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the company. When so executed such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the president and attested by the secretary.

By the following instrument the president has authorized the officers named therein to appoint attorneys-in-fact:

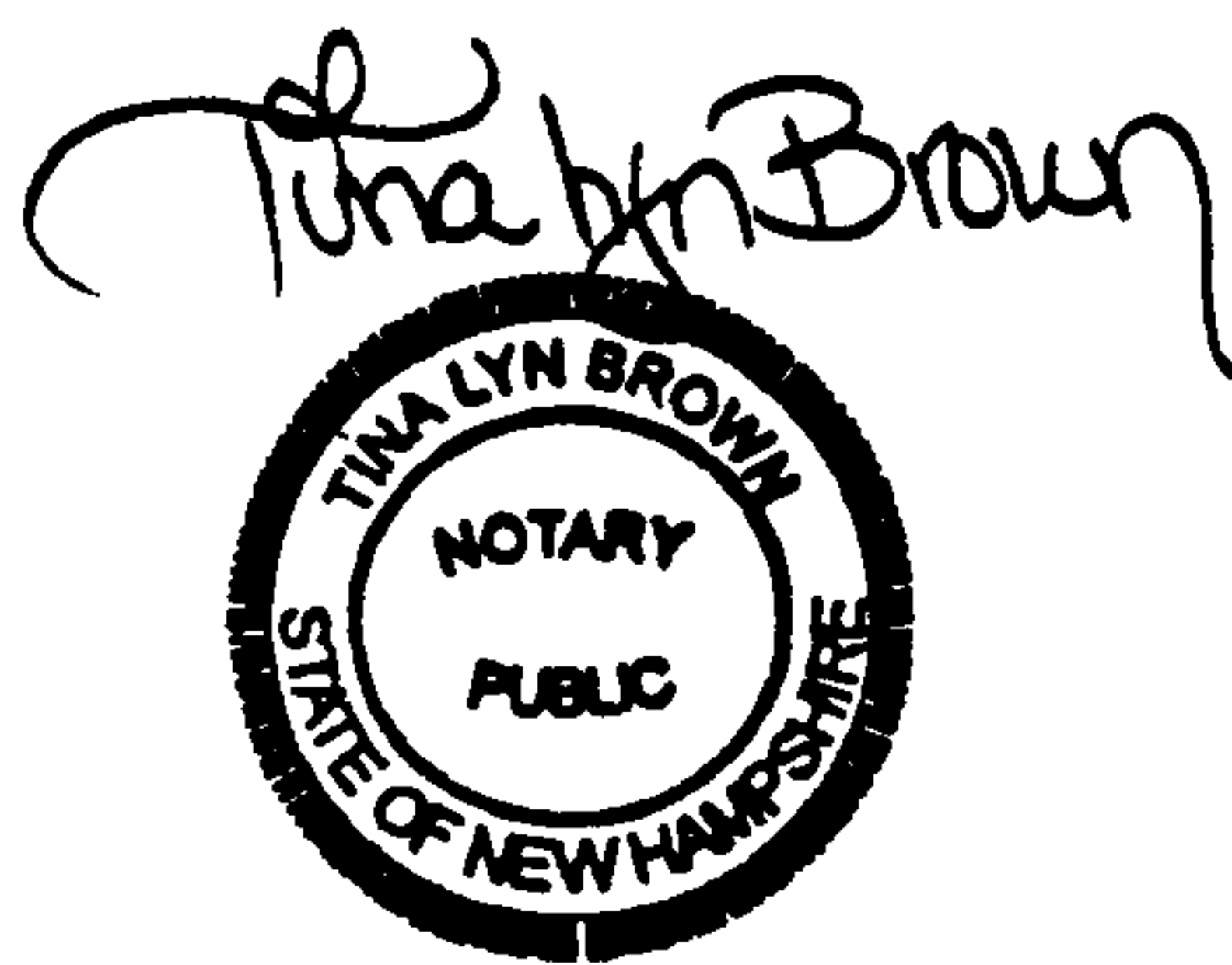


