Know All Men by These Presents: That in consideration of **One hundred thirty two** thousand eight hundred and no/100 (\$132,800.00) to the undersigned grantor (whether one or more), in hand paid by the grantee herein, the receipt where is acknowledged, I or we, **Mary Lou Vonderau and Eugene Vonderau, husband and wife and Christopher Vonderau, a married man** (herein referred to as grantor, whether one or more), grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **Mary K. Jolley and Douglas E. Jolley** (herein referred to as grantee, whether one or more), the following described real estate, situated in **Shelby** County, Alabama, to-wit:

This property does not constitute the homestead of the grantor, Christopher Vonderau, nor his spouse, as defined in Section 6-10-3, Code of Alabama (1975).

Subject to mineral and mining rights if not owned by Grantor.

Subject to existing easements, restrictions, set-back lines, rights of way, limitations, if any of record.

\$132,800.00 of the purchase price recited above was paid from mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.

To Have and to Hold to the said grantee, as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, their heirs and assigns forever; it being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the grantees herein) in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and, if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.

And I (we) do, for myself (ourselves) and for my (our) heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with said grantee, his, her or their heirs and assigns, that I am (we are) lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise stated above; that I (we) have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that I (we) will, and my (our) heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee, his, her or their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.




EXHIBIT "A" LEGAL DESCRIPTION.

Commence at the Southwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 28, Township 20, Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama and run thence North 03°53'43" West along the West line of said quarter-quarter a distance of 967.64 feet to a set rebar corner and the point of beginning of the property being described; thence run North 03°53'43" West a distance of 223.17 feet to a set rebar corner on the Southerly margin of South Shades Crest Road; thence run North 39°33'00" East along said margin of said road a distance of 132.87 feet to a set rebar corner; thence run South 50°40'41" East a distance of 207.91 feet to a set rebar corner; thence run South 49°58'56" West a distance of 300.69 feet to the point of beginning.
