That in consideration of Two Million Nine Hundred Forty Thousand and No/100, (\$2,940,000.00), DOLLARS, in hand paid to the undersigned, American Land Development Corporation, a corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "GRANTOR"), by Tanglewood Corporation, a corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "GRANTEE"), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said GRANTOR does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto GRANTEE the following described real estate, located and situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

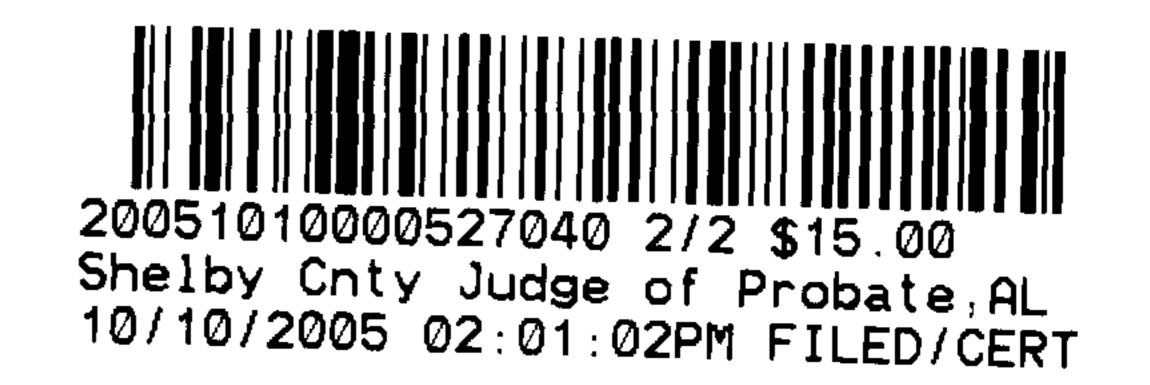
