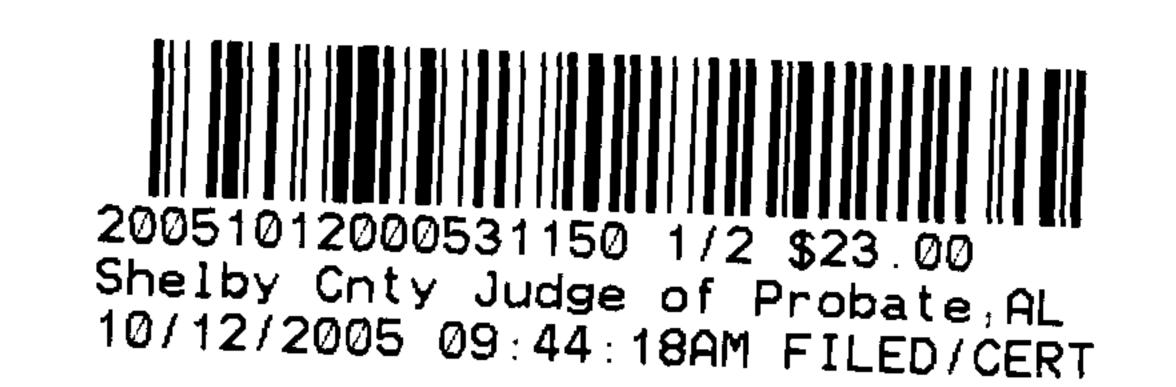

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00), and any other good and valuable considerations to the undersigned grantor (whether one or more), in hand paid by grantee herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, I or we, James S. Spates, and Imogene Wells, as Personal Representatives of the Estate of Mary L. Spates, deceased, Probate Case PR-2005-000077; and James S. Spates, a married man, individually; and Imogene Wells and husband, John M. Wells (herein referred to as grantors) grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto James S. Spates and wife, Judy H. Spates, (herein referred to as grantees), the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

An undivided one-half interest in and to the following described property:

Begin at a point on the North line of the NW ¼ of SW ¼, Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 2 East, where the same is intersected by the East right of way line of Alabama Highway No. 25 and run thence East along the North line of said forty acres and along the North line of the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of said Section, 416 feet; thence run in a Southerly direction and parallel with the East right of way line of said Highway 210 feet; thence run West and parallel with the North line of said forty acres 416 feet to the East right of way line of said Highway; thence run in a Northerly direction along said right of way of said Highway 210 feet to the point of beginning. And I (we) do for myself (ourselves) and for my (our) heirs, executors, and administrators covenant with the said Grantees, their heirs and assigns, and I am (we are) lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all encumbrances unless otherwise noted above, that I (we) have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid, that I (we) will, and my (our) heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to the said Grantees, heirs, executors and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

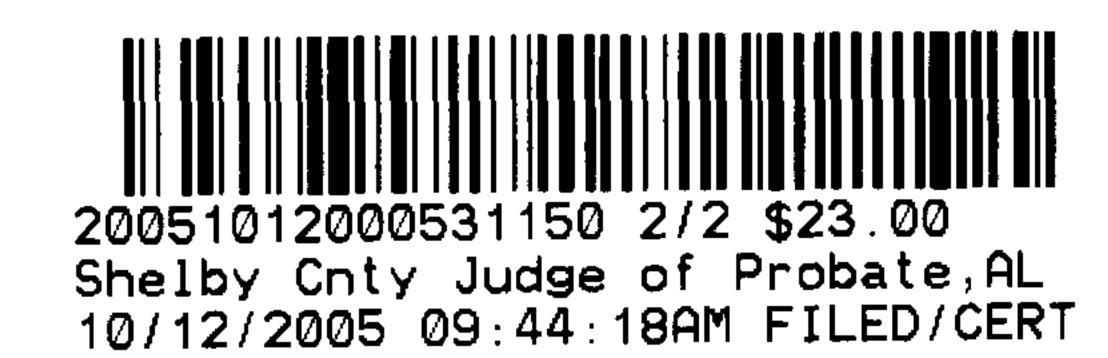
