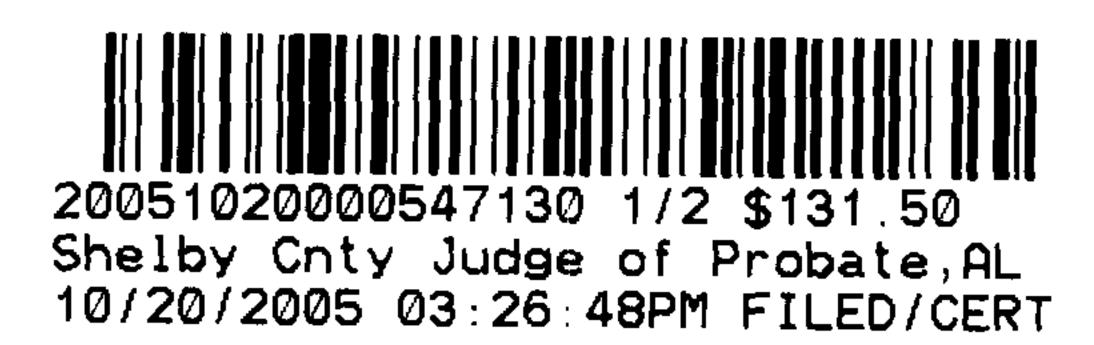

WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That in consideration of

THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$387,500.00)

to the undersigned GRANTOR in hand paid by the GRANTEES, whether one or more, herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

PRIMACY CLOSING CORPORATION, a Nevada Corporation, (herein referred to as GRANTOR) does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto PHILLIP M. UNDERWOOD AND DOROTHY JAN UNDERWOOD (herein

referred to as GRANTEES) as individual owner or as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, if more than one, the following described real estate, situated in the State of Alabama, County of Shelby, to wit:

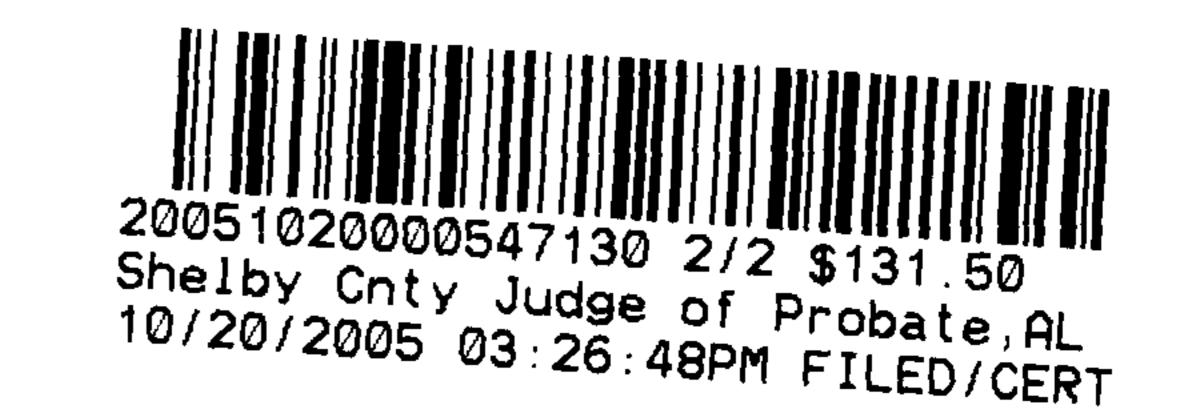
