KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

THAT, WHEREAS, heretofore, on to-wit, 26th day of August, 2004, Leonard Johnson and Janee' Johnson, husband and wife, executed a certain mortgage on property hereinafter described to First National Bank of Shelby County, which said mortgage is recorded in Instrument# 20040831000486460 in the Office of the Probate Judge in Shelby County, Alabama; and


WHEREAS, in and by said mortgage, the mortgagee, its successors or assigns, were authorized and empowered in the event of default, according to the terms thereof, to sell said property before the Courthouse door in the City of Columbiana, Shelby County, Alabama, after giving notice of the time, place and terms of said sale in some newspaper published in said County by publication once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks prior to said sale at public outcry for cash, to the highest bidder, and said mortgage provided that in case of sale under the power and authority contained in same, the mortgagee or any person conducting said sale for the mortgagee was authorized to execute the proper conveyance to the purchaser at said sale; and it was further provided in and by said mortgage that the mortgagee may bid at the sale and purchase said property if the highest bidder therefor; and

WHEREAS, default was made in the payment of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and the same First National Bank of Shelby County did declare all of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage due and payable and said mortgage subject to foreclosure as therein provided and did give due and proper notice of foreclosure of a said mortgage, by U. S. Mail and by publication in *The Shelby County Reporter*, a newspaper of general circulation, published in Shelby County, Alabama, in its issues of October 5, October 12, and October 19, 2005.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of October, 2005, the day on which said foreclosure sale was due to be held under the terms of said notice between the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure was duly and properly conducted and Burt W. Newsome as Attorney-in-Fact for the said First National Bank of Shelby County did offer for sale and sell at public outcry, at the Courthouse in Shelby County, Alabama, the property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, Burt W. Newsome was the Auctioneer who conducted said foreclosure sale for the said First National Bank of Shelby County; and

WHEREAS, the said First National Bank of Shelby County was the highest bidder in the



amount of Two Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$233,750.00), which sum of money First National Bank of Shelby County offered to apply to the costs of foreclosure and then to the remaining balance on the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and said property was thereupon sold to First National Bank of Shelby County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, and the amount of Two Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$233,750.00), the said Leonard Johnson and Janee' Johnson, and First National Bank of Shelby County by and through Burt W. Newsome, the person acting as auctioneer and conducting said sale as their duly authorized agent and Attorney-in-Fact and Auctioneer does hereby GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL AND CONVEY unto the said First National Bank of Shelby County AS IS, WHERE IS, the following described property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:



Begin at the SE corner of SE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 9, Township 20 South, Range 1 East; thence run North along the East line of said 1/4-1/4 Section a distance of 640 feet; thence run west and parallel with the South line of 1/4-1/4 Section a distance of 1,140 feet, more or less, to the Yellow Leaf Creek; thence run South along Yellow Leaf Creek, to the South line of said 1/4-1/4 Section; thence run east along the South line of said 1/4-1/4 Section a distance of 1,220 feet, more or less to the point of beginning; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

The property is located in Shelby County at 5034 Highway 55 Westover, Alabama 35185.

Together with the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging and all fixtures now attached to and used in connection with the premises herein described, subject to right of way easements and restrictions of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and existing special assessments, if any, which might adversely affect the title to the above described property.
