

PREAMBLE: This is a MILITARY POWER OF ATTORNEY prepared pursuant to Title 10 United States Code, Section 1044b, and executed by a person authorized to receive legal assistance from the military services. Federal law exempts this power of attorney from any requirement of form, substance, formality, or recording that is prescribed for powers of attorney by the laws of a State, the District of Columbia, or a territory, commonwealth or possession of the United States. Federal law specifies that this power of attorney shall be given the same legal effect as a power of attorney prepared and executed in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction where it is presented.

SPECIAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW EVERYONE BY THESE PRESENTS, which are intended to constitute a Special Power of Attorney, **THAT I, Michael Bailey**, having an address at 1511 East Tenth Street, Anniston, AL 36207, hereby make, constitute and appoint **Kristi Bailey**, having an address at 1014 Burnt Pine Drive, Maylene, AL 35114, as my attorney-in-fact TO ACT in my name, place and stead in any way which I could do, if I were personally present, to the extent that I am permitted by law to act through an agent:

(a) to do, execute, perform and finish for me and in my name all things which my attorney-in-fact shall deem necessary or appropriate, in and about or concerning my property or any part thereof. In addition, I specifically authorize my attorney-in-fact to sign a note, mortgage and all other documents to refinance the real property at 1014 Burnt Pine Drive, Maylene, Alabama 35114, together with all improvements thereon and rights relating thereto, upon such terms and conditions as my attorney-in-fact may deem advisable, and to execute and sign on my behalf any and all agreements, closing documents and other instruments relating thereto, including without limitation consents, releases, escrows agreements, affidavits and tax returns, and to take such other actions relating to said real property and the refinance thereof as my attorney-in-fact may deem advisable.

To induce any third party to act hereunder, I hereby agree that any third party receiving a duly executed copy or facsimile of this power of attorney may act hereunder, and that revocation or termination hereof shall be ineffective as to such third party unless and until actual notice or knowledge of such revocation or termination shall have been received by such third party. I, for myself and my heirs, executors, legal representatives and assigns, hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless any such third party from and against any and all claims that may arise against such third party by reason of such third party having relied upon the provisions of this power of attorney.

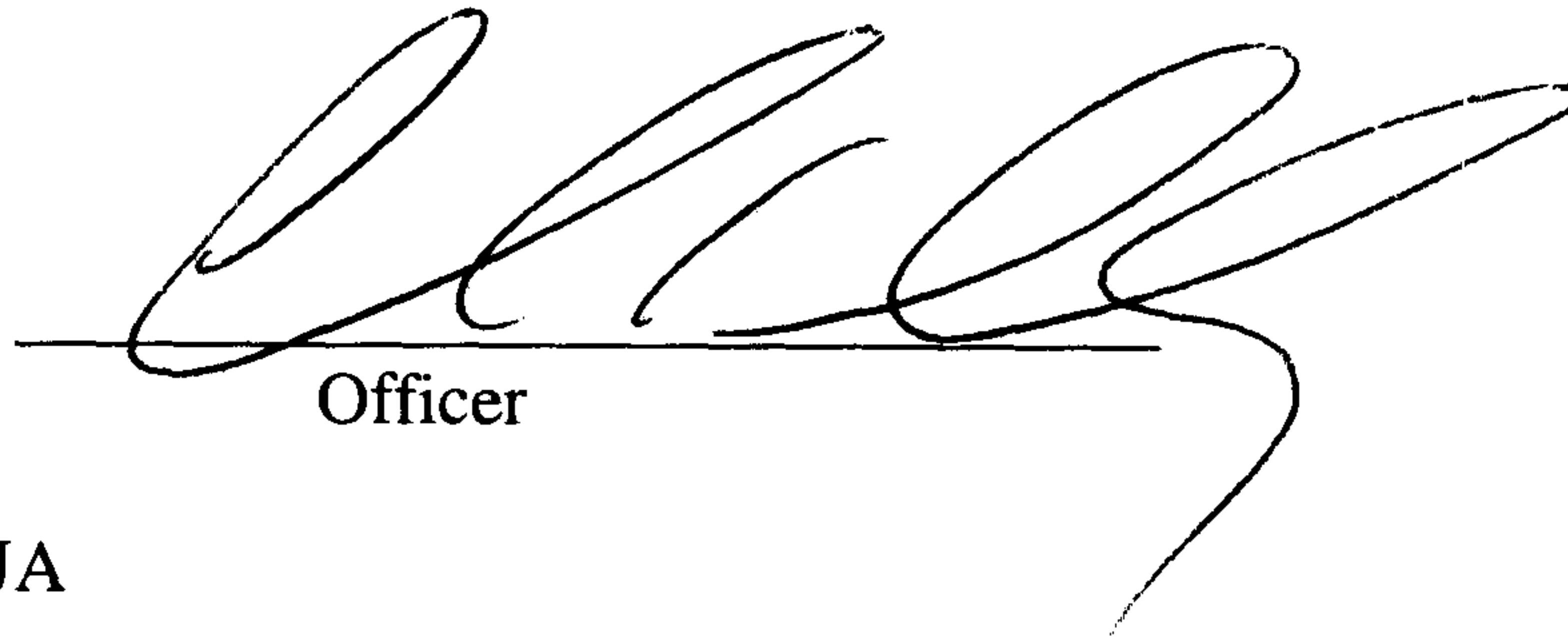
