KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of One Million Two Hundred Eighty Thousand and 00/100 (\$1,280,000.00), and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned John D. Crompton, and wife, Donna K. Crompton, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTORS do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, Anthony G. Chavers and Bishop B. Chavers, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 29, according to the Survey of Greystone, 4th Sector, as recorded in Map Book 16, Page 89 A, B & C, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Together with the nonexclusive easement to use the private roadways, Common Areas and Hugh Daniel Drive, all as more particularly described in the Greystone Residential Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions dated November 6, 1990, and recorded in Real 317, Page 260, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama (which together with all amendments thereot, is hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Declaration")

\$896,000.00 of the consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.


