JOINT SURVIVORSHIP DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, for and in consideration of Seven Hundred Thousand and 00/100 (\$700,000.00), and other good and valuable consideration, this day in hand paid to the undersigned Tu D. Bui, and wife, Thanh Thuy Le, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the GRANTORS do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the GRANTEES, John D. Crompton and Donna Crompton, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described Real Estate, lying and being in the County of Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 2, according to the Amended Map of Greystone, First Sector, Phase VII, as recorded in Map Book 17, Page 53, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. TOGETHER WITH the nonexclusive easement to use the private roadways, Common Areas, and Hugh Daniel Drive all as more particularly described in the Greystone Residential Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions dated November 6, 1990 amd recorded in Real 317, Page 260 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama (which, together with all amendments thereto, is hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Declaration").

Subject To:

Ad valorem taxes for 2005 and subsequent years not yet due and payable until October 1, 2005. Existing covenants and restrictions, easements, building lines and limitations of record.

\$ ALL of the purchase price recited above was paid from a mortgage loan closed simultaneosly TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the tract or parcel of land above described together with all and singular the rights, herewith privileges, tenements, appurtenances, and improvements unto the said GRANTEES, for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor, forever.

AND SAID GRANTORS, for said GRANTORS, GRANTORS' heirs, successors, executors and administrators, covenants with GRANTEES, and with GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, that GRANTORS are lawfully seized in fee simple of the said Real Estate; that said Real Estate is free and clear from all Liens and Encumbrances, except as hereinabove set forth, and except for taxes due for the current and subsequent years, and except for any Restrictions pertaining to the Real Estate of record in the Probate Office of said County; and that GRANTORS will, and GRANTORS' heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to said GRANTEES, and GRANTEES' heirs and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all persons.
