SECOND ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES

OF INCORPORATION OF

RIVERCHASE UNITED APPEAL FUND, INC.


We, the undersigned, Craig Tolbert, President, and Stuart Garrette, Secretary of Riverchase United Appeal Fund, Inc. (the "Corporation"), an Alabama nonprofit corporation, (whose Articles of Incorporation were filed in the office of the Probate Judge for Shelby County, Alabama on December 16, 2003, as Instrument #2003-808620) do hereby certify that the following Second Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation has been duly adopted in accordance with the provisions of sections 10-3A-80 through 10-3A-84, inclusive, *Code of Alabama* (1975):

- (1) The name of the Corporation is Riverchase United Appeal Fund, Inc.
- (2) The Articles of Incorporation are amended as follows:

The text of Section 8 thereof, entitled "Dissolution," is stricken in its entirety, and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, and after payment of all its liabilities, all its remaining assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Code section 501(c)(3), or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama, or the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located if not in Shelby County, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes

- (3) As provided in Section 13 of the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation, there are no members of the Corporation entitled to vote upon this Amendment.
- (4) The above Amendment was unanimously approved by all members of the Corporation's board of directors through a consent in lieu of a meeting, dated $\frac{OCI}{I}$, 2005.


