DEFAULT JUDGMENT

THIS ACTION is before the Court on the request of the Plaintiff, Qualitest Pharmaceuticals, Inc., for a default judgment against the Defendant, *Wood Discount Pharmacy, Inc.*, and the Court, after reviewing, and giving due consideration to, the pleadings and testimony in this matter, finds as follows:

1. The Defendant, *Wood Discount Pharmacy, Inc.*, was duly served with the Summons and Complaint in this matter, and
2. The said Defendant, who is neither an infant, nor an unrepresented, incompetent person, failed to plead, or otherwise defend itself in said matter; and
3. Its default was duly entered on the 2nd day of November, 2005; and
4. The said Defendant has taken no proceedings since such default was entered; and
5. The Plaintiff, Qualitest Pharmaceuticals, Inc., is entitled to recover damages from the said Defendant.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that the Plaintiff, Qualitest Pharmaceuticals, Inc., have and recover, from the said Defendant, *Wood Discount Pharmacy, Inc.*, compensatory damages in the amount of \$18,293.78, plus court costs, for which execution may issue.
