ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

CARL M. CRAWFORD, ARCHITECT, LLC

Pursuant to Ala. Code § 10-12-10 (1975) of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Limited Liability Company ("LLC") Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the LLC is **CARL M. CRAWFORD, ARCHITECT, LLC.**

ARTICLE II
DURATION

The period of duration for the LLC is perpetual, unless all the Members unanimously agree in writing to limit the duration of the LLC.

ARTICLE III
PURPOSES

The LLC has been organized for the following purposes:

(A) To render and engage in the practice and profession of architecture and services ancillary thereto.

(B) To engage in general contracting, building, construction, construction management, ownership and development and management of real property and improvements and all other business incidental thereto.

(C) To engage in any and all other lawful purposes for which limited liability companies can and are organized under the laws of the State of Alabama consistent with paragraphs (A) and (B) above.

ARTICLE VI
RESTRICTION ON MEMBERSHIP INTEREST AND TRANSFER

No person may be a member of the LLC unless he or she is licensed or registered to render professional architectural services in the State of Alabama. A Member's interest in the LLC may be voluntarily transferred only to a person who is licensed or registered to render professional architectural services in the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE VII
ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

Consistent with Article VI above, additional Members may be admitted upon obtaining the written consent of a majority in interest of the remaining Members, the payment or provision of a capital contribution and execution of an admission agreement.

ARTICLE VIII
CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP AND DISSOLUTION

The cessation of membership of one or more members will not result in the dissolution of the LLC.
