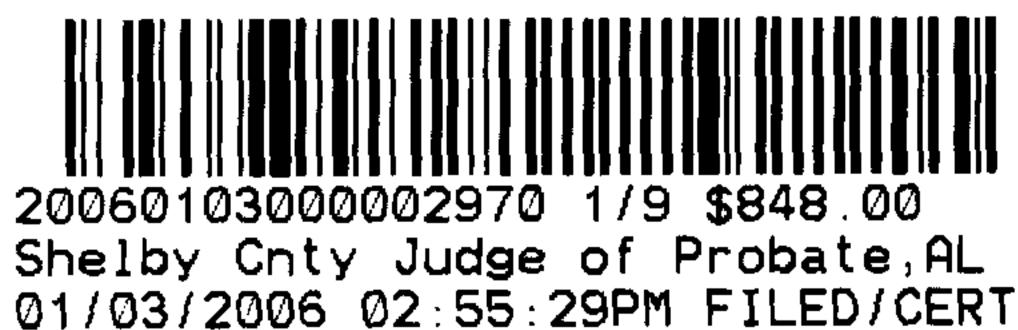

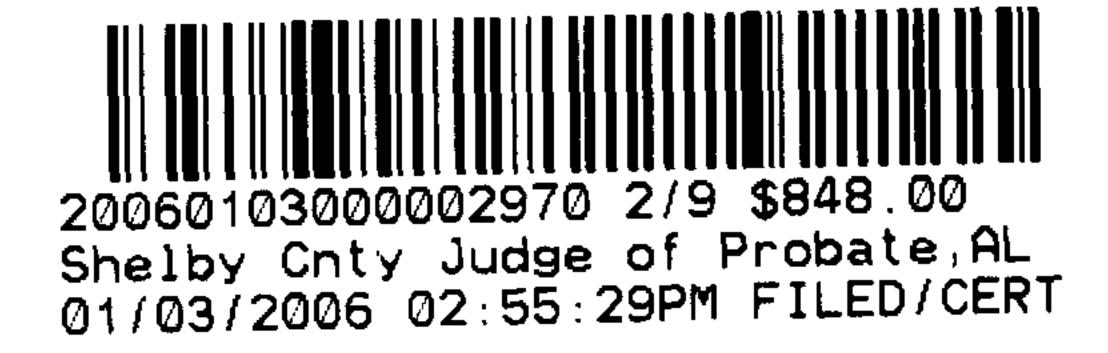

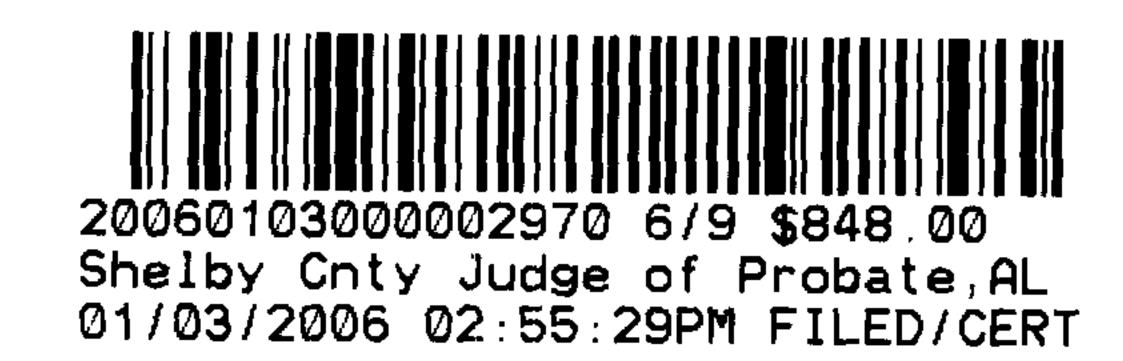

Deed Tax: \$800.00

A tract of land situated in the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 31, Township 19 South, Range 2 west, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows: Commence at the Northwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northewest 1/4 of Section 31, Township 19 South, Range 2 west, Shelby County Alabama, and run in an Easterly direction along the North line of said 1/4-1/4 section a distance of 452.73 feet to a point; thence turn a deflection angle of 86 degrees 31 minutes 40 seconds to the right and run in a Southerly direction a distance of 1321.78 feet to a point; thence turn a deflection angle of 47 degrees 06 minutes 00 seconds to the right and run in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 250.20 feet to a point on the center line of the road; thence turn a deflection angle of 79 degrees 55 minutes 15 seconds to the right and run in a Northwesterly direction along the center line of said road a distance of 34.06 feet to a point; thence turn a deflection angle of 89 degrees 58 minutes 30 seconds to the left and run in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 146.00 feet to a point; thence turn a deflection angle of 38 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds to the right and run in a Southwesterly direction of 152.97 feet to a point on the East right-of-way line of U.S. Highway #31; thence turn a deflection angle of 85 degrees 12 minutes 35 seconds to the left and run in a Southerly direction along the chord of a curve to the right having a radius of 2010.08 feet a distance of 311.77 feet to the point of beginning; thence turn a deflection angle of 97 degrees 33 minutes 22 seconds to the left and run in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 260.00 feet toa point; thence turn an interior angle of 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds and run to the right in a Southeasterly direction a distance of 205.86 feet to a point; thence turn an interior angle of 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds and run to the right in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 315.33 feet to a point on the East right of way line of U. S. Highway #31, said point being a point on a curve; thence turn an interior angle of 71 degrees 55 minutes 02 seconds (angle measured to tangent) and run to the right in a Northerly direction along the arc of a curve to the left having a central angle of 6 degrees 04 minutes 44 seconds and a radius of 2010.08 feet a distance of 213.26 feet to the point of beginning.
