**MORTGAGE FORECLOSURE DEED**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That:

WHEREAS, heretofore on July 30, 2005, **Beverly McKenna, unmarried, Party of the First Part**, executed a certain mortgage to **Mortgage Electronic Registrations Systems, Inc., acting solely as nominee for Homecomings Financial Network, Inc. its successors and assigns**, which said mortgage is recorded in Instrument No. 20020806000369580, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, default in the payment of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc did declare all of the indebtedness secured by the said mortgage due and payable and said mortgage subject to foreclosure as therein provided and did give due and proper notice of the foreclosure of said mortgage, in accordance with the terms thereof, by publication in the Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation in Shelby County, Alabama, in its issues of 11/16, 11/23 & 11/30/2005; and

WHEREAS, on January 5, 2006, the day on which the foreclosure sale was due to be held under the terms of said notice, during the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure was duly and properly conducted and the person conducting the sale on behalf of the mortgagee did offer for sale and sell a public outcry, in front of the main entrance of the Courthouse, Shelby County, Alabama, the property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the highest and best bid obtained for the property described in the aforementioned mortgage was the bid of Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc in the amount of **NINETY-THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN AND 73/100 DOLLARS (\$93,917.73)**; which the person conducting the sale on behalf of the mortgagee offered to credit on the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and said property was thereupon sold to Deutsche Bank; and

WHEREAS, James Greer, Esq., conducted said sale and acted as auctioneer thereat, under and pursuant to an appointment as such by the Party of the Second Part; and

WHEREAS, said mortgage expressly authorized the mortgagee or auctioneer or any person conducting said sale to execute to the purchaser at said sale a deed to the property so purchased.

Part of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows: Commence at the Intersection of the South line of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 23 and the centerline of Shelby County Highway No. 47; thence run Westerly along said South line 43.45 feet to the Southwesterly right of way of said highway, the point of beginning of the property herein described; thence continue along the South line of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 23, 528.10 feet; thence turn 90 degrees 52 minutes 30 seconds right and run Northerly 210.0 feet; thence turn 89 degrees 07 minutes 30 seconds right and run Easterly 435.75 feet to said right of way line; thence turn 67 degrees 01 minutes right and run Southeasterly 228.08 feet to the point of beginning.
