ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION GUIDELINES

INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: The name of the Limited Liability Company must contain the words Limited Liability Company, LLC or L.L.C.

Step 2: File the original and two copies of the Articles of Organization in the county where the LLC's registered office is

LOCATED. THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S FILING FEE IS \$40. PLEASE CONTACT THE JUDGE OF PROBATE TO VERIFY THE PROBATE

FILING FEE.

Pursuant to the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act, the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization.

Article I The name of the Limited Liability Company: JP Enterprises, LLC

Article II The duration of the Limited Liability Company is perpetual.


Article III The Limited Liability Company has been organized for the following purpose(s): Investing in Real Estate; Buying, Holding, Renting, and Selling.
