

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE CHURCH OF COMMON GROUND

BE IT KNOWN, that the undersigned, subscriber hereto pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama governing such cases do make and file these Articles of Incorporation with the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, for the purposes of forming a corporation.

ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be The Church of Common Ground.


ARTICLE 2. DURATION OF THE CORPORATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE 3. PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

The corporation has been organized for the following purposes:

- 3.1 The purpose for which this organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- 3.2 To work as a community of believers, to promote the gospel of Jesus Christ amongst ourselves and all people.
 - 3.3 To license, ordain, and oversee ministers of the gospel.
- 3.4 To provide ministry, food, clothing, and other items to needy people throughout the world.
- 3.5 To do any and all other things therein above set forth to the same extent as any natural person or person might or could do, and to any and all things necessary, suitable, or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or for the attainment of any of the objects or for the exercise of any of the powers herein above set forth, whether herein specified or not, either along or in connection with other firms, individuals, or corporation, to do any act or acts, thing or things, incident to or in connection with any business mentioned, or any part or parts thereof, to the extent not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Alabama, and to have and to exercise all powers that may now or hereafter be conferred upon or allowed to corporations organized under the laws of the State of Alabama.



- 3.6 The several clauses contained in the statement of purpose shall be constructed both as purpose and powers and the statements contained in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in wise limited or constructed by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause, but will be regarded as independent purposes and powers. The business or purpose of this corporation is from time to time to do any one or more of the acts and things herein set forth and it is hereby expressly provided that the enumeration or specific purposes and powers of this corporation shall always be construed to prevail to prevent this corporation forever becoming subject to or subsidiary or subordinate or amendable to any other organization.
- 3.7 Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal Income Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, State, or local Government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit of Shelby County, Alabama in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
- 3.8 It is intended that the foregoing numeration of specific purposes or objects, authorities, or powers shall both be held to not limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation but shall be in the furtherance of, and in addition to, and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE 4. QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS AND MANNER OF ADMISSION

The Church of COMMON GROUND shall have members. The manner of election, appointment, or admission, the qualifications, the rights and responsibilities shall be set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE 5. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT


