THAT IN CONSIDERATION OF **Two Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand One Hundred Fifteen and 00/100 (\$257,115.00) Dollars** and other good and valuable consideration to the undersigned Grantors in hand paid by the Grantees herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, **Barbara Auffant Terry, the Personal Representative of the Estate of Jeanne Stoner Auffant, Shelby County Probate Case No. PR-2005-000592**, (herein referred to as Grantors, whether one or more), do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto **Donald L. Roberson and Fredna C. Roberson, husband and wife** (herein referred to as Grantees, whether one or more), as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate, situated in the State of Alabama, County of Shelby, to-wit:

1. Existing easements, restrictions, current taxes, set-back lines, rights of way, limitations, if any, of record.

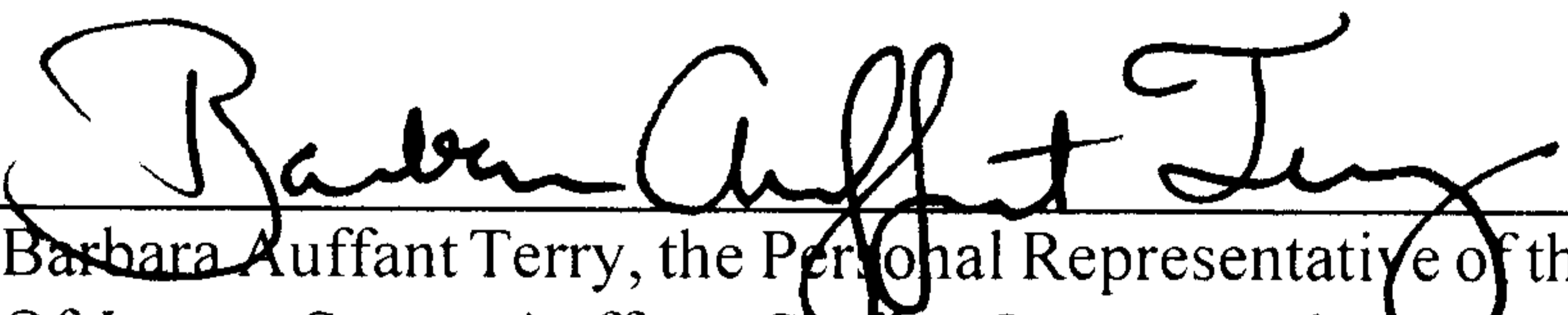
NOTE: \$50,000.00 of the above consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage filed simultaneously herewith.
