

AUCTIONEER'S DEED

STATE OF ALABAMA COUNTY OF SHELBY

WHEREAS, CHARLES L. DUNN, a married man and KELLY M. WHEREAS, default was made in the payment of said indebtedness described in and secured by said mortgage; and

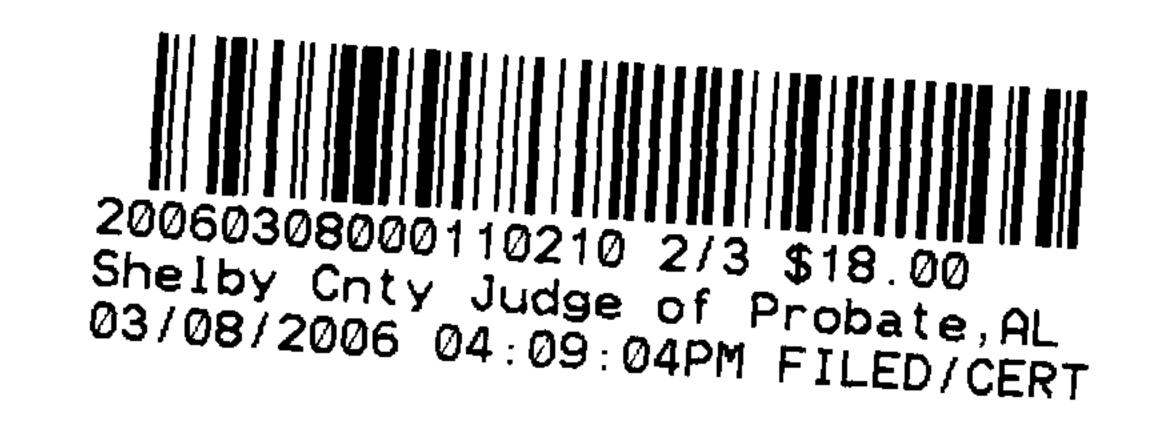

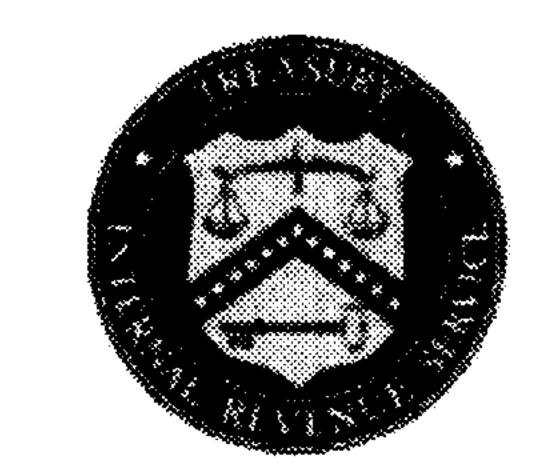
