

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

Pursuant to the Provisions of Sections 10-12-1, et seq. of the <u>Code of Alabama</u> (1975), the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I

Purposes

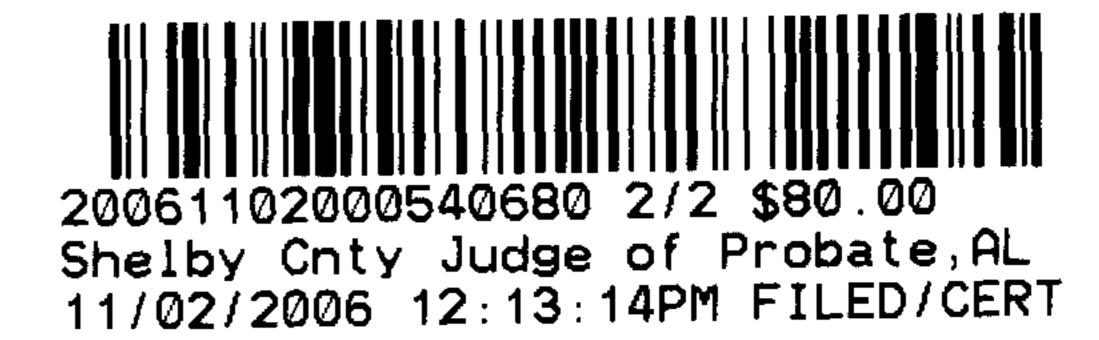
The purposes for which the Company is formed are:
