ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ALABAMA TACTICAL OFFICERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned Officers of Alabama Tactical Officers Association, Inc., an Alabama nonprofit corporation (the "Corporation"), pursuant to the Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Act (Title 10, Chapter 3A of the <u>Code of Alabama</u>, 1975), and any act amendatory thereof, supplementary thereto or substituted therefor, hereby adopt the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

- 1. The name of the corporation is Alabama Tactical Officers Association, Inc.
- 2. ARTICLE THREE (III) of the Articles of Incorporation of Alabama Tactical Officers Association, Inc. shall be amended by deleting the existing ARTICLE THREE in its entirety and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

The corporation is organized exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. Specifically, this corporation will network, educate, and train police, fire and medical first responders, provide a forum for the exchange of ideas, information, training, research and development of new methods used to enhance the successful execution of missions in the tactical environment, and develop a database of information regarding police tactics that can be used for the betterment of an existing team or aid in the development of a new team.



No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Fourth hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the <u>Internal Revenue Code</u> of 1986, or any future <u>Internal Revenue Code</u>, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purposes.

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

- 5. This amendment was adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation on October 2, 2006.
- 6. A meeting of the membership of the Corporation was held on the 4th day of October, 2006, at which meeting a quorum was present. The foregoing amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the Members of the Corporation by at least two-thirds of the votes entitled to be cast by members present or represented by proxy at such meeting.


