ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

D & B HOMES, LLC

TO THE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the undersigned hereby adopt the following Limited Liability Company Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the limited liability company ("Company") is D & B HOMES, LLC:

ARTICLE II

DURATION


The period of duration for the Company shall be from the date of filing these Articles of Organization with the Office of the Judge of Shelby County, Alabama (the "Filing Date"), until the earliest to occur of the following:

- (1) The fiftieth (50th) anniversary of the Filing Date;
- (2) Dissolution of the Company by the unanimous written agreement of the Members; or

(3) The occurrence of an event which under the Act constitutes an event of dissociation or otherwise works a termination of the Company under the Act, unless the legal existence and business of the Company are continued pursuant to Article VII below.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES



The Company has been organized for the following purposes:

- (1) to purchase, take, receive, lease or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, develop, use and otherwise deal in or with, real or personal property, or any interest therein, wherever situated, and to manage, market, sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of real or personal property, or any interest therein, and to engage in any and all business activities related to or incidental thereto;
- (2) to construct both residential and commercial structures; to own, purchase, sell, and develop real estate; lease real estate; and to manage, market, sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer and otherwise dispose of real and personal property, or any interest therein, and to engage in any and all business activities related to or incidental thereto; and
- (3) For any lawful purpose or purposes for which a limited liability company may be organized under the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE IV

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT



ARTICLE VII


ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

Members of the Company shall have the right to admit new members from time to time. Additional members may be admitted only upon the unanimous written consent of the existing members, and such existing members shall determine the amount and nature of contributions by new members at the time such new members are admitted.

ARTICLE VIII

CONTINUATION OF BUSINESS

The cessation of membership of one or more members will not result in the dissolution of the Company.



ARTICLE IX

MANAGEMENT

The management of the Company shall be vested in its members. The members shall have the right and authority to manage the business or affairs of the Company and to make all decisions with respect thereto, subject to the terms and conditions of the Company's Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE X

POWERS

The Company shall have the same powers as a natural person to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its business and affairs, including, without limitation, the powers set forth in §10-12-4, Code of Alabama (1975), as the same may hereafter be amended from time to time.
