Now, there in consideration of the Premises, the undersigned Executrix of the Last Will and Estates of Coleman B. Pennington and wife, Carole Pennington, has this day bargained, sold and by those presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Marie Annette Pennington and Lee Pennington, the following described tract or parcel of land lying in Shelby County, Alabama, and particularly bounded and described as follows:

A part of Lot 1, according to the recorded map of Weaver Farms, as recorded in Map Book 13, page 38, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows:


Begin at the SW corner of Lot 1 of Weaver Farms as recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama; thence run North along said ¼-1/4 line a distance of 600.00 feet; thence turn an angle of 89 degrees 07 minutes 10 seconds right and run a distance of 377.19 feet; thence turn an angle of 70 degrees 31 minutes 53 seconds right and run a distance of 265.00 feet thence turn an angle of 73 degrees 03 minutes 54 seconds right and run a distance of 589.95 feet to the point of beginning.

.Subject to taxes for 1999 and subsequent years, easements, restrictions, rights of way, and permits of record.
