That they will pay all taxes, assessments, or other liens taking priority over this mortgage when imposed upon the mortgaged property, and should default be made in the payment of the same, or any part thereof, Mortgagee may pay the same (but Mortgagee is not obligated to do so). If the mortgaged property or any part thereof is a unit in a condominium or a planned unit development. Mortgagors shall perform all of Mortgagors' obligations under the declaration or covenants creating or covering the condominium or planned unit development, the bylaws and regulations of the condominium or planned unit development, and constituent documents. That if possession of the mortgaged property is allowed to remain in any other person or entity to the exclusion of Mortgagors for a period of one year or more, or if all or any part of the mortgaged property or any interest therein is sold. assigned, transferred or conveyed by Mortgagors, or any of them, without Mortgagee's prior written consent, excluding only (a) the creation of a purchase money security interest for household appliances, (b) a transfer by devise, descent or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant, or (c) the grant of any leasehold interest of one year or less (including all mandatory or optional renewal periods) not containing an option to purchase, Mortgagee may, at Mortgagee's option, declare all indebtedness secured by this mortgage to be due and payable immediately with or without notice to Mortgagee may condition its consent to any such transfer of possession of, or an interest in, the mortgaged property upon the transferee's agreeing to pay a greater rate of interest on all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage or to adjust the payment schedule of all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this mortgagee's approval of the creditworthiness of the transferee, and upon the transferee's payment to Mortgagor of a reasonable transfer or assumption fee. That all the covenants and agreements of Mortgagors herein contained shall extend to and bind their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, and that such covenants and agreements and all options, rights, privileges and powers herein given, granted or secured to Mortgagee shall inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of Mortgagee. 12. That the provisions of this mortgage and the Agreement secured hereby are severable, and that the invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this mortgage or of such Agreements shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions or this mortgage or of such Agreements. The remedies provided to Mortgagee herein are cumulative with the rights and remedies of Mortgagee at law and in equity, and such rights and remedies may be exercised concurrently or consecutively. A carbon or photostatic copy of this mortgage may

be filed as a financing statement in any public office. This mortgage shall continue in full force and effect until all of the indebtedness (including future advances) secured by this mortgage shall have been paid in full.
