ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SOCK MONKEY MINISTRIES, INC.

These articles of incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporator for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the provisions of Alabama Nonprofit Corporation Act as codified in Section 10-3A-1, et seq. Code of Alabama (1975) as follows:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this non-profit corporation shall be SOCK MONKEY MINISTRIES, INC., and shall be hereinafter referred to as the "corporation".

ARTICLE II: DURATION

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSES


This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that also qualify as Section 501(c)(3) exempt organizations. To this end the corporation shall through a community of volunteers, share a passion to offer God's love through a simple act of agape, inspiring hope in the lives of orphaned children, cancer patients, AIDS patients, homeless families, and those in need of encouragement. The corporation will provide a handmade gift that is altruistically assembled by our volunteers to fulfill our vision to reach a life, one gift at a time. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.

ARTICLE IV: MEMBERS

The corporation shall have no voting members. The management and affairs of the corporation shall be at all times under the direction of a Board of Directors, whose operations in governing the corporation shall be defined by the corporation's by-laws. No Director shall have any right, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.

ARTICLE V: ADDRESS AND REGISTERED AGENT

The street address of the registered office of the corporation is: In the County of Shelby, 525 Lime Creek Cove, Chelsea, Alabama 35043 and the registered agent at such address is Elizabeth VanSickle.



ARTICLE VI: BOARD OF DIRECTORS; OFFICERS

The initial board of directors shall consist of five (5) persons and the said Board of Directors will elect four officers that will make up the Executive Board, including a president, one or more vice-presidents, a secretary, and a treasurer. The same person can hold more than one office, except for the offices of president and secretary. 
ARTICLE VII: INCORPORATOR

Name and address of the incorporator is: Elizabeth P. VanSickle – 525 Lime Creek Cove, Chelsea, AL 35043

ARTICLE VIII: LIMITATIONS

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

- 1. No part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to any member of the corporation not qualifying as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, nor to any Director or officer of the corporation, nor to any other private persons, excepting solely such reasonable compensation that the corporation shall pay for services actually rendered to the corporation, or allowed by the corporation as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the corporation.
- 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.



4. The corporation shall not lend any of its assets to any officer or director of this corporation, or guarantee to any person the payment of a loan by an officer or director of this corporation.

ARTICLE IX: POWERS

The corporation shall have all of the general powers expressly granted to non-profit corporations under the provisions of the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act and all other powers necessary or useful in order to enable the corporation to carry out its purposes as set forth in Article III hereof.

ARTICLE X: BYLAWS

The operation of the corporation shall be governed by bylaws to be adopted at the organizational meeting of the corporation. The Board of Directors is authorized to make, alter, amend, or repeal the Bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE XI: DEBT OBLIGATION AND PERSONAL LIABILITY

No member, officer or Director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers or Directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE XII: DISSOLUTION


The corporation may be dissolved as provided for in the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE XIII: AMMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by action of the Board of Directors of the corporation, in accordance with the Bylaws and the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE XIV: ORGANIZATION

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law).


