

SCRIVENER'S AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared William R. Justice, who, being known to me and after being duly sworn by me, deposes and says as follows:

I am an attorney at law, and I am the scrivener who prepared a deed from Charles William Vansant and Nancy Gail Vansant to Connie Vansant, dated August 19, 2005, and recorded as Instrument # 20050825000438070 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. There is an error in the legal description contained in the deed.

The correct description is:

A 40-foot wide easement for ingress, egress, and utilities described as commencing at the SW corner of the NE¼ of the NW¼, Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 1 East; thence run N 00° 08′ 31″ W along the West line of said ¼-¼ section a distance of 53.02 feet to the point of beginning of said easement; thence continue along last described course a distance of 609.63 feet to the SW corner of the Vansant Family Subdivision, as recorded in Map Book 35, Page 66, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; thence turn right and run N 89° 58′ 33″ E along the South line of said subdivision a distance of 40.00 feet; thence turn right and run S 00° 08′ 31″ E a distance of 609.63 feet; thence turn right and run S 89° 55′ 18″ W a distance of 40.00 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

This affidavit is given for the purpose of correcting the erroneous description as set out above.
