



Cain, to be Executor of this Will, without bond, and hereby direct that he shall not be required to file an inventory or final settlement, or to report his acts and proceedings as such Executor to any Court, and I hereby grant to and vest in my said Executor full power and authority to sell, at private sale, and to convey, lease, exchange, mortgage, pledge, and otherwise alienate any or all of the assets of my estate, on such terms as he deems to be proper in his sole discretion, without the order of any Court, and to borrow money on behalf of my estate, and to continue to operate any business in which I may be engaged at the time of my death, either individually or as a member of a partnership, or otherwise. I further vest in and grant to my said Executor authority to do each and every act or thing that he may consider to be necessary, convenient, or proper in and about the administration and management of my estate, it being my purpose and intention to grant to him all of the powers over said property and estate that I am capable of granting to him as such Executor.




I hereby amend the "THIRD" Item of my said Last Will and Testament by adding thereto another paragraph. Said paragraph shall read as follows:






