



**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
AAA GROUND WORKS LLC
A LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY
ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF ALABAMA**

The undersigned, acting as the organizers of a limited liability company under Ala. Code §10-12-1, The Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act"), hereby adopt the following Articles of Organization for AAA GROUND WORKS, LLC (herein after called the "Company")

ARTICLE I

The name of the Company is AAA GROUND WORKS, Limited Liability Company (LLC).

ARTICLE II

The company shall continue in existence until it is dissolved in accordance with the provisions of the operating agreement, or, if there is no operating agreement or no provision in the operating agreement governing the duration of the Company, then in accordance with the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act or applicable laws.

ARTICLE III

The company is organized for the purpose of engaging in any lawful business activity.

ARTICLE IV

The mailing address of the initial registered office is 4111 Eagle Crest Drive Birmingham, Alabama 35242, and the name of the initial registered agent of the Company at such address is John A. Rice.

ARTICLE VI

The initial member of the Company may admit additional members at such times and upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed by the Company and the additional members.

ARTICLE VII

The legal existence and business of the Company may be continued by the written consent of all the remaining members within (10) days after the event of disassociation of a member.

ARTICLE VIII

The Company shall be managed by one or more managers. The names and mailing addresses of the initial manager, who will serve as managers until the first annual meeting of the members of the Company or until his or their successors as duly elected are:
