Whereas, the Shelby County Health Department shall perform the applicable investigation and provide the approval letter for said action.


**Now therefore**, be it resolved that upon recording with the Probate Office, the Shelby County Commission does hereby approve "The Jones Family Cemetery".



I understand that the Shelby County Health Department will visit the site; and once it is approved, a Resolution will follow from the Shelby County Commission approving the family cemetery.



I, Chester A. Harris, a registered Land Surveyor for Surveying Solutions, Inc., certify that I have surveyed a Family Cemetery situated in the Northwest quarter of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at a ½ inch rebar found locally accepted to be the Northeast corner of said Northwest quarter; thence run in a Southerly direction along the East line of said Northwest quarter for a distance of 1,049.27 feet to a point; thence turn an angle to the right of 90 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 568.85 feet to an iron pin set at the point of beginning; thence turn an angle to the left of 18 degrees, 37 minutes, 53 seconds and run in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 74.29 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the right of 62 degrees, 13 minutes, 05 seconds and run in a Northwesterly direction for a distance of 89.72 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the right of 66 degrees, 10 minutes, 26 seconds and run in a Northeasterly direction for a distance of 130.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence turn an angle to the right of 102 degrees, 41 minutes, 50 seconds and run in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 89.39 feet to the point of beginning; said Family Cemetery containing 8,617 square feet, more or less.

I further certify that all parts of this survey and drawing have been completed in accordance with the current requirements of the Standards of Practice for Surveying in the State of Alabama to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, that I have consulted the Federal Insurance Administration "Flood Hazard Boundary Map" and found that this property is located in Zone "X" Unshaded, according FIRM Community Panel No: 010191 0435, Unincorporated Shelby County, Alabama, dated: September 29, 2006; that the correct address is as follows: 4250 County Highway 30, according to my survey of April 19, 2007.
