## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

THAT, WHEREAS, heretofore, on to-wit, 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2005, Graves Land Development, Inc., executed a certain mortgage on property hereinafter described to Mutual Savings Credit Union, which said mortgage is recorded in Instrument#20050413000174790 in the Office of the Probate Judge in Shelby County, Alabama; and

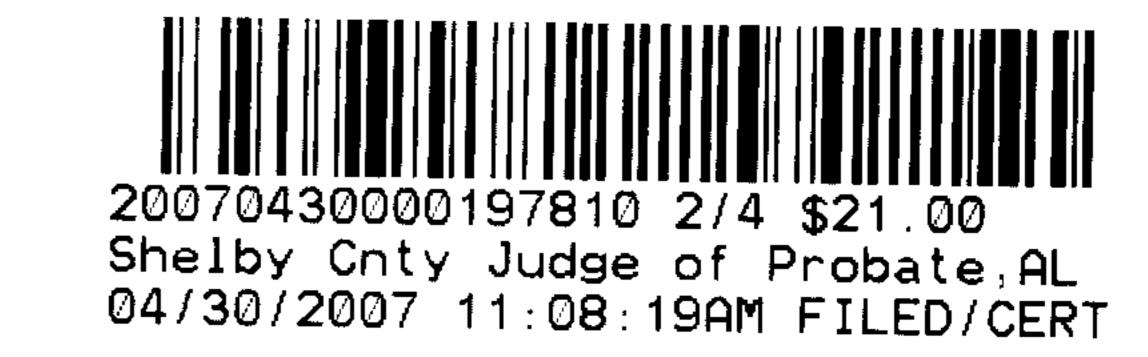

WHEREAS, default was made in the payment of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and the same Mutual Savings Credit Union did declare all of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage due and payable and said mortgage subject to foreclosure as therein provided and did give due and proper notice of foreclosure of a said mortgage, by U. S. Mail and by publication in *The Shelby County Reporter*, a newspaper of general circulation in Shelby County, Alabama, in its issues of December 14, December 21, and December 28, 2006.

WHEREAS, on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2007, the day on which said foreclosure sale was due to be held under the terms of said notice between the legal hours of sale, said foreclosure was duly and properly conducted and Burt W. Newsome as Attorney-in-Fact for the said Mutual Savings Credit Union did offer for sale and sell at public outcry, at the Courthouse in Shelby County, Alabama, the property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, Burt W. Newsome was the Auctioneer who conducted said foreclosure sale for the said Mutual Savings Credit Union; and

WHEREAS, the said Mutual Savings Credit Union was the highest bidder in the amount of



One Million Three Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty and 47/100 (\$1,385,780.47), which sum of money Mutual Savings Credit Union offered to apply to the costs of foreclosure and then to the remaining balance on the indebtedness secured by said mortgage, and said property was thereupon sold to Mutual Savings Credit Union.
