Tract One:


Commence at the Southeast corner of Section 3, Township 24, North, Range 12 East; thence run North along the East line of Section 3 a distance of 2685.08 feet; thence turn an angle of 62 degrees 14 minutes to the left and run a distance of 464.18 feet; thence turn an angle of 14 degrees 56 minutes to the left and run a distance of 621.70 feet to a point on the North right of way line of Highway No. 25; thence turn an angle of 5 degrees 42 minutes to the left and run along the North line of said highway a distance of 292.0 feet; thence turn an angle of 83 degrees 02 minutes to the right and run a distance of 477.60 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue in the same direction a distance of 486.20 feet to a point on the South line of the old Montevallo-Calera road; thence turn an angle of 120 degrees 10 minutes to the right and run along the South line of said road a distance of 335.45 feet; thence turn an angle of 59 degrees 50 minutes to the right and run a distance of 353.55 feet; thence turn an angle of 96 degrees 58 minutes to the right and run a distance of 292.0 feet to the point of beginning, situated in the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 24 North, Range 12 East.



## **ORDER**

Comes now Emily Ward, as Personal Representative of the Estate of SAMUEL C. WARD, deceased, and presents to the Court her Petition in writing, under oath, for a consent settlement of her administration of such estate under and pursuant to the provisions of Section 43-2-506, Code of Alabama, 1975.

Now come also Jane Ward Singleterry, a sister; William M. Ward, a nephew; Emily Ward, a niece; John Franklin Ward, a nephew; Charles Patrick Ward, a nephew; and James Andrew Ward, as all the heirs-at-law and next-of-kin of said SAMUEL C.WARD, deceased, and do hereby file their written consent herein to such consent settlement, which said instrument is executed and acknowledged as required by law; and

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that Jane Ward Singleterry, William M. Ward, Emily Ward, John Franklin Ward, Charles Patrick Ward, and James Andrew Ward, are over the age of nineteen years, of sound mind, who are all of the legatees, distributees and devisees of SAMUEL C.WARD, deceased, and the only persons entitled to share in the distribution of said estate; and

It further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that under and pursuant to the provisions of Section 43-2-506, Code of Alabama, 1975, and under and pursuant to the instruments this day presented to the Court and from other good and sufficient evidence, that the Petition for a consent settlement should be granted; and

It further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that all legal charges, claims, costs and expenses incident to the administration of said estate have been fully paid; except for those fees below which are approved by this Court for payment:

(1) Personal Representative fee - \$40,000.00
(2) Wallace Lyons, Accountant - 500.00
(3) William M. Hawkins, Jr., Attorney fee 2,500.00

Furthermore, it is understood that there may be some additional tax liability that the personal representative will pay from the remaining proceeds and then pay the heirs their respective shares.

It further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that said Personal Representative has performed all the duties imposed upon her herein, that such estate should be settled by consent, that such Personal Representative should be discharged from her office; and that said Personal Representative and the surety bond holder, State Farm Fire and Casualty Company, a corporation of Illinois be relieved and discharged from any and all other and further liability for and on account of the administration of said estate.
