1) The **Deed** had the wrong legal description and should have been shown as follows:

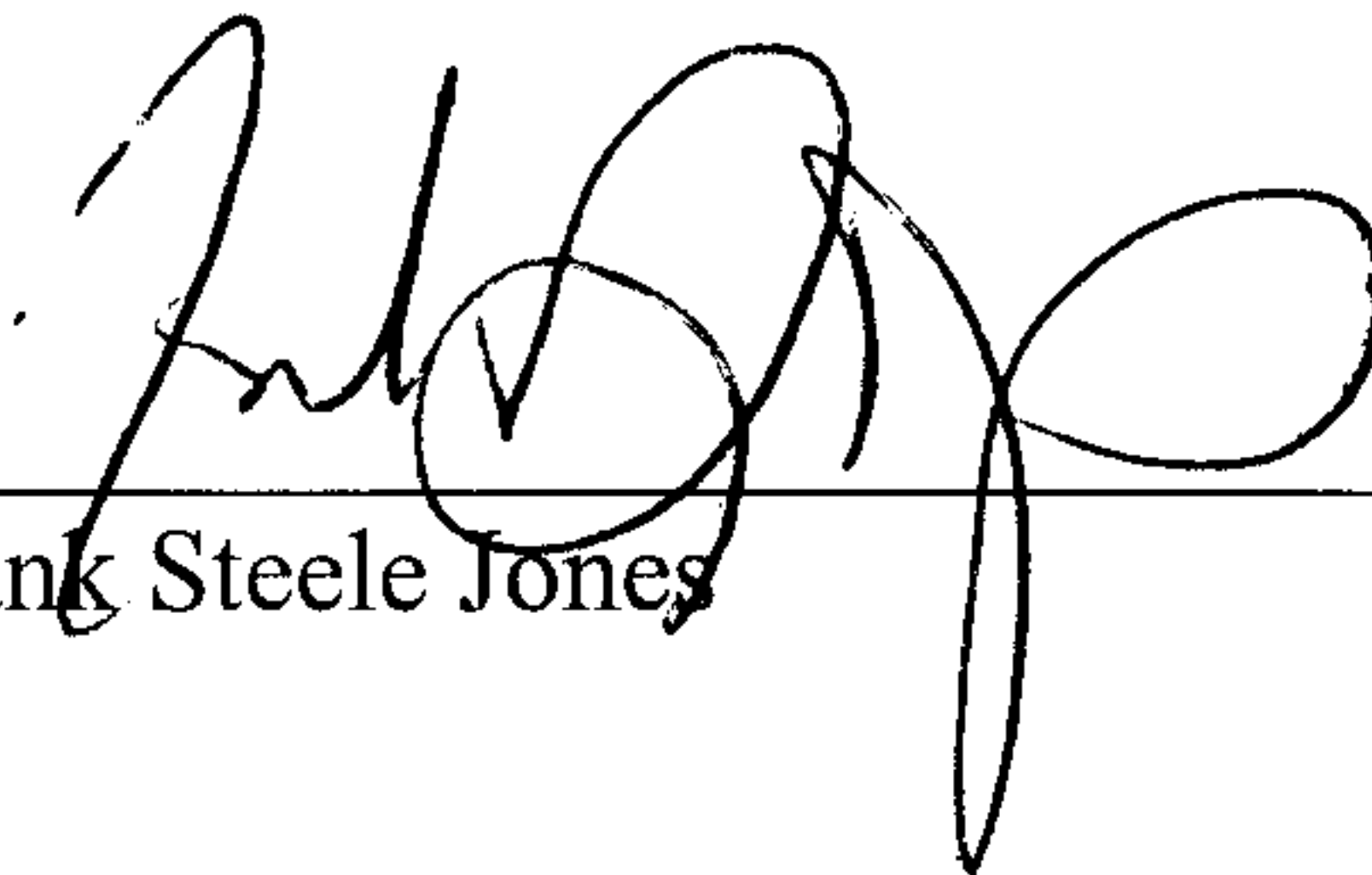

Further the Affiant sayeth not."

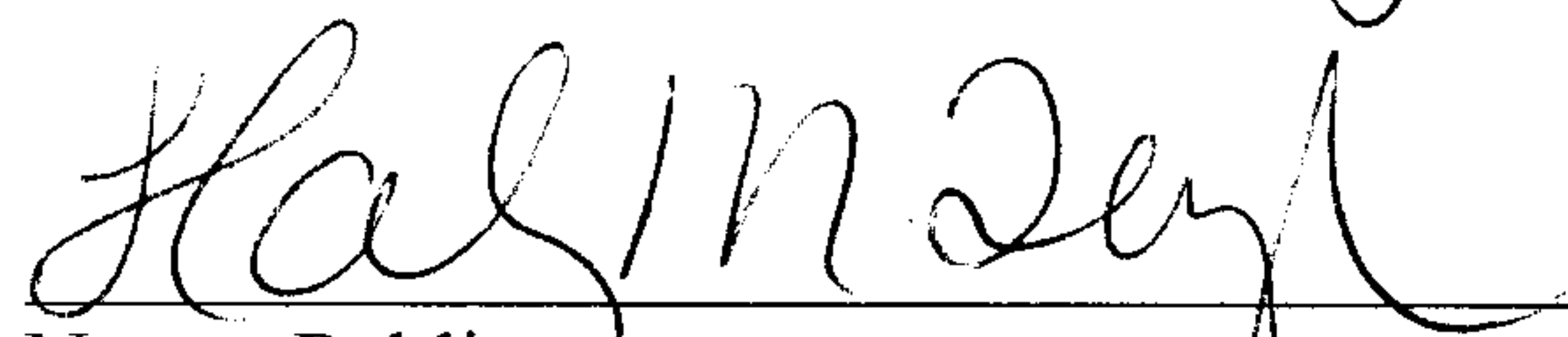
