FINDINGS AND DECISION OF PLANNING COMMISSION

This matter came to be heard before the Planning Commission of the Town of Westover, Alabama (the "Planning Commission"), at a public hearing on the 22nd day of May, 2007, and upon a consideration of the matter, the Planning Commission finds as follows:

- 1. All notices and public hearings had been given in the form and in the manner prescribed by applicable law and the pertinent provisions of the subdivision regulations of Westover, Alabama.
- 2. The Planning Commission is empowered to grant the waiver applied for by the applicant under Section 6:02 of the subdivision regulations.
- 3. It is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and general welfare that the waiver be granted and any detrimental effect that may occur would be suffered by a very small group of owners, if any, and will be far outweighed by the overall benefits received by the community as a whole.

It is therefore resolved and decided by the Planning Commission of the Town of Westover, Alabama, that the application for waiver is hereby granted.
