ORDER ON DEFAULT

This matter came before the Court on the Application for Default and Affidavit for Default, with attached Exhibit A, filed by the Plaintiff. Based upon the pleadings, the Court is of the opinion that the following Order should be entered.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Plaintiff's Verified Petition for Rule Nisi was filed on April 5, 2005.
2. That service was perfected on Defendant via publication on 00/00/0000.
3. Per the terms of the Final Judgment of Divorce entered on October 22, 2003, Defendant is found to be in default as to Periodic Alimony in the amount of \$18,199.59.
4. Per the terms of the Final Judgment of Divorce entered on October 22, 2003, Defendant is found to be in default towards payments on the loan from Plaintiff's retirement account in the amount of \$20,121.64.
5. Per the terms of the Final Judgment of Divorce entered on October 22, 2003, Defendant is found to be in default in the payment of court costs in the amount of \$844.74.
6. Per the terms of the Final Judgment of Divorce entered on October 22, 2003, Defendant is found to be in contempt in the payment of moving expenses, and attorney's fees in the amount of \$10,122.54.
7. That the total amount of sums awarded to Plaintiff in the Final Judgment of Divorce was \$39,114.50, with interest on said sum in the amount of \$10,174.01. Defendant is found to be in contempt for the total sum of \$49,288.51 as collectively reflected in paragraphs 3, 4, 5, and 6 above.
