

JUDGMENT QUIETING TITLE

- 1. The Court noted that publication of the pendency of this action was made in the Shelby County Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation in Shelby County, Alabama on July 12, 2006; July 19, 2006; July 26, 2006 and on August 2, 2006, calling upon the Defendants to plead, answer or otherwise defend on or before thirty days from the 1st day of September, 2006. More than thirty days has elapsed from the date of the last publication of said notice and the filing of a certified copy thereof in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County.
- 2. The Guardian ad Litem, Vonda Felton, actively participated in the taking of testimony in this action and the court finding that the complaint in this action complies in all respects with the requirements of Alabama Code §§ 6-6-560 and 561,



it is of the opinion of the court that the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for in the Complaint.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED:

1. The right, title and interest and ownership of the Plaintiff in and to the property is hereby established and forever quieted in rem and against all named and fictitious party Defendant and the property which is more particularly described as:
