

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

BRANDON HARWELL PROPERTIES, LLC

To The Judge Of Probate Of Shelby County, Alabama:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Limited Liability Company Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"); the undersigned hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization.

Article I The **name** of the Limited Liability Company is:

BRANDON HARWELL PROPERTIES, LLC

Article II The **duration** of the Limited Liability Company is:

Unless it is dissolved and its affairs wound up as provided in the Operating Agreement or as may be required by the Act, the Company shall have perpetual duration and succession in its name beginning on the date these Articles are filed with the Judge of Probate.

Article V The Company has been organized for the following **purposes**:

1. To engage in the business of acquiring, owning, developing, improving, operating, leasing, selling and otherwise dealing in and with improved and unimproved real property directly and indirectly.
2. For any lawful purpose or purposes for which a limited liability company may be organized under the laws of the State of Alabama.

Article VI Admission of new members:

Members of the Company shall have the right to admit new members from time to time. Additional members may be admitted only upon written consent of the existing members or by a majority vote of the existing members and such existing members shall determine the amount and nature of contributions by new members at the time such new members are admitted.

Article VII Management of the Company:

The management of the Company shall be vested in its members. The members shall have the right and authority to manage the business or affairs of the Company and to make all decisions with respect thereto, subject to the terms and conditions of the Company's Operating Agreement.

Article VIII The powers of the Company:

The Company shall have the same powers as a natural person to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its business and affairs, including, without limitation, the powers set forth in 10-12-4, *Code of Alabama* (1975), as the same may hereafter be amended from time to time.
