



Liens attaching to all the property of the taxpayer were filed to secure the amount owed. The notices of lien were filed with the Judge of Probate, for the County of Shelby, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

The liens listed above are attached to certain property described as:

Lot 51-A , according to the map of Southlake Townhomes, First Addition, being a resurvey of a part of Lot 44, Lots 45 through 64 and acreage, Southlake Townhomes as recorded in Map Book 13, Page 32 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

The property is commonly known as 4646 Lake Valley Drive, Birmingham, Alabama 35244.

The Internal Revenue Service acknowledges receipt of ninety thousand seven hundred and twenty dollars (\$90,720.00), and discharges the liens against the above described property. However, the liens remain in effect for all other property, or rights to property, to which the liens are attached.
