We are encouraged by the recent progress made by our two companies towards reaching agreement on a master agreement for power line crossings of Norfolk Southern (and subsidiaries) rights-of-way. We anticipate finalizing a master agreement for such crossings in the near future. At present, we have pending applications to Norfolk Southern for the crossings described below and have submitted therewith the required drawings and \$500.00 application fees. We understand that these crossings have been approved by Norfolk Southern subject to Alabama Power Company giving Norfolk Southern prior notice of when the installation work will be done together with an additional payment for each crossing in the amount of \$2,500.00. The pending crossings are as follows:

- 1. Perpendicular crossing in Pell City, 123 feet west of Mile Post 266 (1083112);
- 2. Perpendicular crossing in Sawyerille-Hale County, Mile Post 63 plus 2204 (1083119);
- 3. Perpendicular crossing in Attalla, Mile Post 86 plus 2080 West (1083123);
- 4. Perpendicular crossing in Gadsden, Mile Post 86 plus 3650 (1083124);
- 5. Perpendicular crossing in Parrish, Mile Post 838 plus 530 feet southwest (1083143);
- 6. Perpendicular crossings in Plantersville, Dallas County, Mile Post 170+1952.7, both shown on APCO drawing number A-402259 (1083138).

Upon finalizing and executing the master agreement, the crossing described above would be governed by the terms and conditions of the master agreement and Alabama Power Company would pay any additional amounts due in addition to the \$3,000.00 paid for each of these crossings that may be provided for in the master agreement. Alabama Power Company and Norfolk Southern have agreed to work in good faith towards finalizing and executing the proposed master agreement as soon as possible. In the interim, the permission granted for the crossings described above will remain in effect and will be terminable only upon not less than sixty (60) days prior written notice by Norfolk Southern to Alabama Power Company that an identified crossing is not being maintained in accordance with industry (railroad and electric power) standards and that the crossing identified in such notice is terminated. Alabama Power Company shall perform any repairs deemed necessary by Norfolk Southern and shall provide notification to Norfolk Southern of all work performed promptly after its completion. In the event Alabama Power Company fails to take steps to perform any such repairs, including immediate steps in the event of an emergency, Norfolk Southern shall have the right, but not the obligation, to perform or have such repairs performed at the sole cost and expense of Alabama Power Company.

We appreciate your ongoing efforts in working toward finalizing the proposed master agreement as well as consideration of the crossings described herein. Please acknowledge the agreement of Norfolk Southern to the contents of this letter by executing a copy hereof and returning it to me.




