EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION BHS, L.L.C. TO SHELBY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

Parcel A

A parcel of land situated in the East half of Section 7, Township 20 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the Southeast corner of the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of said Section; thence run in a Westerly direction along the South line of said 1/4-1/4 Section for a distance of 947.20 feet to a point; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 91° 39′ 05" and run in a northerly direction for a distance of 356.62 feet to a found capped rebar LS #9587; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 88° 01′ 31" and run in an Easterly direction for a distance of 200.47 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS, said point also being the point of beginning; thence turn an exterior angle to the right of 89° 59′ 46" and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 60.00 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 269° 59′ 46″ and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 200.47 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 180° 00′ 14" and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 490.64 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS, said point also being on the Easternmost right-of-way line of Shelby County Road 35 (80' right-of-way) and said point also being on a curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 1260.81 feet, a central angle of 27° 03′ 09″, an interior chord angle to the left of 83° 08′ 19" and a chord distance of 589.79 feet; thence run in a Northwesterly direction along the arc of said curve and along said right-of-way for a distance of 595.30 feet to a found ½ inch rebar; thence leaving said right-of-way, and said curve turn an interior chord angle to the left of 95° 20′ 44" and run in an Easterly direction for a distance of 107.88 feet to a found ½ inch rebar; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 272° 21′ 56″ and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 556.40 feet to a found ½ inch rebar; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 61° 39′ 19" and run in a Southeasterly direction for a distance of 908.29 feet to a found nail and flagging in the top of a fence post; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 117° 31′ 41″ and run in a Southerly direction for a distance of 424.82 feet to a found capped rebar LS #9587; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 269° 59′ 05″ and run in an Easterly direction for a distance of 319.96 feet to a found capped rebar LS #9587; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 90° 03′ 56" and run in a Southerly direction for a distance of 242.39 feet to a found 5/8 inch rebar; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 119° 54′ 03" and run in a Southwesterly direction for a distance of 225.43 feet to a found capped rebar LS #9587; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 150° 00′ 43" and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 409.93 feet to the point of beginning.

Commence at the Southeast corner of the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of said Section; thence run in a Westerly direction along the South line of said 1/4-1/4 Section for a distance of 947.20 feet to a point; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 91° 39′ 05" and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 356.62 feet to a found capped rebar LS #9587; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 88° 01′ 31" and run in an Easterly direction for a distance of 200.47 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence turn an exterior angle to the right of 89° 59′ 46" and run in a Northerly direction for a distance of 60.00 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 269° 59′ 46″ and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 200.47 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 180° 00′ 14" and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 490.64 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS, said point also being on the Easternmost right-of-way line of Shelby County Road 35 (80' right-of-way) and said point also being on a curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 1260.81 feet, a central angle of 27° 03′ 09″, an interior chord angle to the left of 83° 08′ 19″ and a chord distance of 589.79 feet; thence run in a Northwesterly direction along the arc of said curve and along said right-of-way for a distance of 595.30 feet to a found ½ inch rebar, said point also being the point of beginning, said point also being on a curve turning to the left, said curve having a radius of 1,434.89 feet, a central angle of 12° 51′ 43″, an exterior chord to chord angle to the right of 160° 02' 34" and a chord distance of 321.43 feet; thence run in a Northwesterly direction along the arc of said curve and along said right-of-way line for a distance of 322.11 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence leaving said curve turn an interior chord angle to the left of 186° 25′ 51″ and run in a Northwesterly direction along said right-of-way line for a distance of 143.29 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence leaving said right-of-way line turn an interior angle to the left 64° 11′ 45" and run in an Easterly direction of 223.58 feet to a set capped rebar stamped GSA CA-560-LS; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 97° 07′ 37" and run in a Southerly direction for a distance of 426.58 feet to a found ½ inch rebar; thence turn an interior angle to the left of 87° 38′ 04" and run in a Westerly direction for a distance of 107.88 feet to the point of beginning.
