Olive Missionary Baptist Church, Inc., a corporation having its principal place of business in Harpersville, Alabama, that the said Church purchase and mortgage the herein described property for the sum of Forty Thousand and NO/100 (\$40,000.00) Dollars and that the Trustees of the Church issue, execute and deliver to said bank a mortgage for the real property attached hereto located in Shelby County, Alabama, said property being more particularly described and attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part of theses minutes.

IN ADDITION, the said Trustees of the Church are authorized to execute and deliver such other instruments as may be required to conclude the transaction.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Trustees of the Church be and they are hereby authorized and directed to consummate and close said real estate sale and to execute and deliver to a mortgage and any agreements, assignments or other documents which may be necessary, proper and convenient in the closing of said transaction, all such documents to be in such form and to contain such provisions as may be satisfactory to said Trustees and Purchaser.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, upon motion duly made and seconded, duly adjourned.




EXHIBIT A LEGAL DESCRIPTION
